



## **GRAIN BUYER LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE**

### **NORTH DAKOTA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION**

<u>License Type</u>	<u>License Fee</u>
Facility-Based Grain Buyer	\$300.00
Late fee per location for a renewal received after July 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$100.00

North Dakota Century Code section 60-02.1-07 provides:

. . . A facility-based grain buyer must obtain a license for each receiving location operated in the state. If a grain buyer operates two or more facilities in the same city or siding, in conjunction with each other and with the same working force, and where but one set of books and records is kept for all such facilities, and scale tickets and checks of but one series are issued for the grain, purchased, only one license is required for the operation of all such facilities. . . .

<u>License Type</u>	<u>License Fee</u>
Roving Grain Buyer	\$200.00
Late fee for a renewal received after July 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$100.00

North Dakota Century Code section 60-02.1-07.1 provides:

. . . Roving grain buyers that purchase, solicit, merchandise, or take possession of grain in this state must obtain an annual license from the commission. . . .
