

Fuel Cost Adjustment**

Case No. PU-06-218

NSP decreased its electric fuel cost adjustment by 0.066 cents per kWh from 0.792 cents per kWh. The resulting fuel cost adjustment for May is 0.726 cents per kWh.

Combining NSP's Fuel Cost Adjustment with its 1.092 cents per kWh base cost of fuel already included in base tariff rates brings NSP's total cost of fuel for the month of June to 1.818 cents per kWh as shown on the graph below.

As a result of this change, the electric bill for a typical NSP residential customer consuming 750 kWh will decrease by \$0.49 for bills rendered in the month of June.
