

Fuel Cost Adjustment**

NSP increased its electric fuel cost adjustment by 0.196 cents per kWh from 1.676 cents per kWh. The resulting fuel cost adjustment for May is 1.872 cents per kWh.

Combining NSP's fuel cost adjustment with its 1.092 cents per kWh base cost of fuel already included in base tariff rates brings NSP's total average cost of fuel and purchased energy for billing during the month of May to 2.964 cents per kWh as shown on the graph below.

As a result of this change, the electric bill for a typical NSP residential customer consuming 750 kWh will increase by \$1.47 for bills rendered during the month of May.
