

About BNSF Railway


- A Berkshire Hathaway company

Rail Transports Hazardous Materials Safely

- Since 2000, the train accident rate is down 27% and hazmat accident rates are down 75%
- 2023 record year for workplace safety with fewest injuries & lowest injury frequency rate in the company's 175-year history
- 99.99% of all BNSF hazmat shipments reach their destination without a derailment caused release.



First Responder Training

BNSF and the railroad industry train first responders in their communities under a longstanding program called *"TRANSCAER" (Transportation Community Awareness and Emergency Response)*

- Hands-on equipment in field Instructor lead

- Incident assessment

BNSF trained more than 4,000 local first responders in 2022.

More than **128,000 emergency responders** trained by BNSF since 1996.






BNSF's Capital Investments

BNSF Agricultural Products Breakdown






