NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

September 7, 2022

A public hearing will be held on demand response and demand flexibility practices at 10 a.m., Central Time on November 17, 2022, in the Commission Hearing Room, 12th floor, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota. On November 15, 2021, the President of the United States signed The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA"), H.R. 3684, 117th Cong. (2021). Pursuant to the IIJA, Section 111(d) of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (16 U.S.C. 2621(d)) was amended ("Amendments") by adding the following standard:

Each electric utility shall promote the use of demand-response and demand flexibility practices by commercial, residential, and industrial customers to reduce electricity consumption during periods of unusually high demand.

The issue to be considered in this proceeding is whether the Commission should consider establishing rate mechanisms to allow an electric public utility to timely recover the costs of promoting demand-response and demand flexibility practices.
