NDPSC to Hold Public Hearings on Enbridge Pipeline Project

BISMARCK, N.D.—The North Dakota Public Service Commission will hold public hearings next week on Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC's siting applications for a proposed 299 mile, \$1.3 billion, 24-inch crude oil pipeline in Williams, Mountrail, Ward, McHenry, Pierce, Towner, Ramsey, Nelson, and Grand Forks counties. The proposed project also calls for the expansion of the existing Beaver Lodge pump station in Williams County, the expansion of the existing Stanley pump station in Mountrail County, the expansion of the existing Berthold pump station in Ward County, and the construction of a new pump station near Lakota in Nelson County.

The hearings are scheduled for Grand Forks at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday Feb. 19 in the Baker Courtroom at the University of North Dakota School of Law; Devils Lake at 8:30 a.m. Thursday Feb. 20 in the Robert Fawcett Auditorium at Lake Region State College; and Minot at 8:30 a.m. Thursday Feb. 27 at the Minot City Council Chambers.

The hearings provide an opportunity for members of the public to contribute to the Public Service Commission's official record. Any comments from members of the public must be received at the hearing to be part of the record. People with concerns, questions or support for the project are encouraged to attend the hearing and present the information. Information received after the hearing will not be part of the official record and cannot be used as a basis for the Commission's decision.

The hearing schedule provides for the company to present its case and answer questions from the Commissioners, after which the Commissioners will take comments from the public.
