Commissioners,

In 2001, the commission ordered in 00-521 to allow NSP to recover costs associated with cleaning up its Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) site over an 8 year period with no rate base treatment. The recovery of costs through the purchased gas adjustment (PGA) is now complete.

NSP filed a tariff revision May 29 removing the MGP surcharge adjustment from its interruptible transportation service tariff. A specific tariff revision was necessary initially to charge these customers for their share of clean up costs because they are not subject to the PGA.

The filing and tariff revision is insignificant and will be allowed go into effective automatically without further paperwork, unless the commission would like to see it on the agenda for approval.

Dave, Send Janet a non-legislative version of the tariff with the new case number and effective date of June 29 for tariff files. The order date will remain blank. Mike
