ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

March 28, 2001

On February 1, 2001, in Case No. PU-2038-01-52, Quest filed an application for approval of a second amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with IdeaOne Telecom Group LLC of Kindred, ND. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for CLEC to CLEC cross connects and sub-loop unbundling.

The amendment was filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under section 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement (or portion thereof) adopted by negotiation if it finds that:

1. the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement;
2. the implementation of the agreement (or portion thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In addition, the Commission may include in its review state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry under section 253. Section 252(e)(4) requires that the Commission must act to approve or reject an agreement adopted by negotiation within ninety (90) days after submission by the parties.

On February 7, 2001, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments which provided that the Commission would receive written comments on the agreement until March 15, 2001. No comments have been received.

The Commission has reviewed the amended agreement and finds that it does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement. The Commission further finds that implementation of the agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.


Order

The Commission orders:

1. The interconnection agreement second amendment negotiated between Qwest Corporation and IdeaOne Telecom Group, LLC, filed with the Commission on February 1, 2001, is APPROVED.
2. The Commission retains continuing jurisdiction over the agreement at all times.
3. Notice of any changes to the agreement must be filed promptly with the Commission.
4. The agreement must not be assigned, assumed or otherwise transferred without the approval of the Commission.
5. Each party to the agreement shall respond reasonably and in good faith to the other party's requests to implement the agreement.





On January 31, 2001, in Case No. PU-2482-01-47, Qwest filed an application for approval of a service resale agreement negotiated with Preferred Carrier Services, Inc. of Addison, Texas. This agreement sets forth rates, terms and conditions under which Qwest agrees to provide services for resale.

On January 31, 2001, in Case No. PU-2483-01-48, Citizens Telecommunications Company of North Dakota (Citizens) filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement negotiated with Midcontinent Communications of Sioux Falls, South Dakota. This agreement sets forth terms and conditions under which Citizens will assume the obligations of a previously approved agreement between Qwest and Midcontinent Communications.

Also on January 31, 2001, in Case No. PU-2484-01-49, Citizens filed an application for approval of a service resale agreement negotiated with Comm South Companies, Inc. of Dallas, Texas. This agreement sets forth rates, terms and conditions under which Citizens agrees to provide services for resale.

On February 1, 2001, in Case No. PU-2038-01-52, Quest filed an application for approval of a second amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with IdeaOne Telecom Group LLC of Kindred, ND. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for CLEC to CLEC cross connects and sub-loop unbundling.

Also on February 1, 2001, in Case No. PU-2463-01-53, Qwest filed an application for approval of a first amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with Integra Telecom of North Dakota, Inc. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for unbundled network elements combinations, customized routing and shared interoffice transport.

These agreements were filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under section 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement (or portion thereof) adopted by negotiation if it finds that:

1. the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement;
2. the implementation of the agreement (or portion thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In addition, the Commission may include in its review state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry under section 253. Section 252(e)(4) requires that the Commission must act to approve or reject an agreement adopted by negotiation within ninety (90) days after submission by the parties.



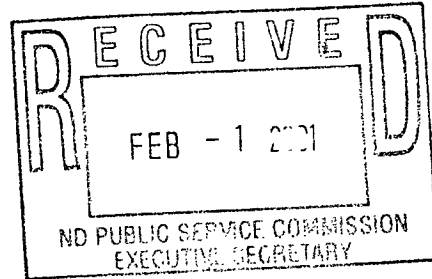

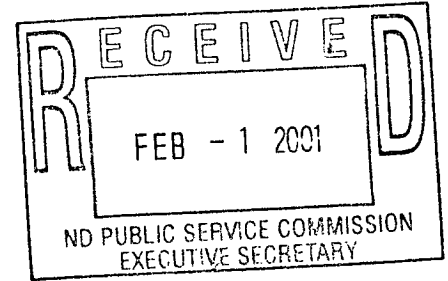

This is Amendment No. 2 ("Amendment") to the Interconnection Agreement between IdeaOne Telecom Group LLC ("IdeaOne"), a North Dakota Limited Liability Company and Qwest Corporation f/k/a U S WEST Communications, Inc. ("Qwest"), a Colorado corporation. IdeaOne and Qwest shall be known as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interconnection Agreement, for the state of North Dakota, that was executed on January 14, 1999, and approved by the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") on April 29, 1999 (the "Agreement").

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement under the terms and conditions contained herein.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Amendment Description

The Agreement is hereby amended by adding Section 7.8 CLEC to CLEC Cross Connects and Section 8.4, Sub-loop Unbundling (and associated rates), to the Agreement, as set forth in Attachment 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

2. Effective Date

This Amendment shall be deemed effective upon approval by the Commission; however, the Parties may agree to implement the provisions of this Amendment upon execution.

3. Further Amendments

Except as modified herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. Neither the Agreement nor this Amendment may be further amended or altered except by written instrument executed by an authorized representative of both Parties.

The Parties intending to be legally bound have executed this Amendment as of the dates set forth below, in multiple counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.

ATTACHMENT 1

7.8 CLEC to CLEC Cross Connects

7.8.1 Qwest shall design and engineer the most efficient route and cable racking for the connection between CLEC's equipment in its collocated spaces to the collocated equipment of another CLEC located in the same Qwest Wire Center; or to CLEC's own non-contiguous Collocation space. CLEC shall have access to the designated route and construct such connection, using copper, coax or optical fiber equipment utilizing an Qwest-approved vendor or another vendor of CLEC's own choosing, subject to Qwest's approval, which may not be unreasonably withheld. CLEC may place its own fiber, coax or copper cable connecting facilities outside of the actual physical Collocation space, subject only to reasonable NEBS Level 1 safety limitations using the route specified by Qwest. CLEC may perform such interconnections at the ICDF, if desired. CLEC may interconnect its network as described herein to any other collocating carrier, to any collocated affiliate of CLEC, to any end user's Premises, and may interconnect CLEC's own collocated space and/or equipment (i.e. CLEC's physical Collocation and CLEC's virtual Collocation on the same Premises). CLEC-to-CLEC Connections shall be ordered in accordance with the CLEC to CLEC ordering Section below.

7.8.2 Ordering – CLEC to CLEC Connections

7.8.2.1 **Application** -- Upon receipt of a complete Collocation Application as described in the above Section, Qwest will perform a feasibility study to determine if adequate cable racking can be found for the placement of CLEC's copper, coax, or fiber optic cable used to interconnect CLEC's physically collocated equipment that is in separate locations in the same Qwest Premise, or to another CLEC's equipment in the same Premise. The feasibility study will be provided within ten (10) calendar days from date of receipt of a complete Application.

7.8.2.1.1 If Qwest determines that the Application is not complete, Qwest shall notify CLEC of any deficiencies within ten (10) calendar days of the Application. Qwest shall provide sufficient detail so that CLEC has a reasonable opportunity to cure each deficiency. To retain its place in the collocation queue for the requested Premise, CLEC must cure any deficiencies in its Application and resubmit the Application within ten (10) calendar days after being advised of the deficiencies.

7.8.2.2 **Quotation** -- If existing cable racking is available, Qwest will provide CLEC with a quote and the specific cable rack route assigned to CLEC with the feasibility study. If additional cable racking is required to accommodate CLEC's request, Qwest shall provide a quote to CLEC no later than twenty-five (25) calendar days of providing the feasibility study. CLEC-to-CLEC Connection quotes will be honored for thirty (30) calendar days from the date the quote is provided. During this period, the space is reserved pending CLEC's approval of the quoted charges.

7.8.2.3 **Acceptance** -- There are two (2) forms of acceptance for CLEC to CLEC Connections:

7.8.2.3.1 CLEC-to-CLEC connections with existing cable rack. CLEC must submit, via wire transfer, payment of 100% of the quoted non-recurring charges with its acceptance. Upon receipt of a complete Collocation Acceptance, CLEC may begin placement of its copper, coax, or fiber cables along the Qwest designated cable rack route.

7.8.2.3.2 CLEC-to-CLEC connections using new cable rack – Upon receipt of a Complete Acceptance from CLEC, as described in the above Section, Qwest will begin construction of the new cable rack.

7.8.2.4 **Interval** – The construction interval for CLEC-to-CLEC Connections requiring the construction of new cable rack by Qwest shall depend upon whether CLEC provides its Acceptance within seven (7) calendar days of the quotation.

7.8.2.4.1 **Applications with Timely Acceptance** – If CLEC provides a complete Acceptance within seven (7) calendar days of receipt of the Qwest collocation quotation, Qwest shall complete its installation of the collocation arrangement within ninety (90) calendar days of the receipt of the complete Collocation Application.

7.8.2.4.2 **Applications with Late Acceptance** -- If CLEC provides a complete Acceptance more than seven (7) calendar days but less than thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the Qwest collocation quotation, Qwest shall complete its installation of the collocation arrangement within ninety (90) calendar days of the receipt of the complete Collocation Acceptance. If CLEC submits its acceptance more than thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the Qwest quotation, the Application shall be resubmitted by CLEC.

8.4 Sub-Loop Unbundling

8.4.1 Description

8.4.1.1 Sub-loop is defined as any portion of the loop that it is technically feasible to access in Qwest's terminals in outside plant, i.e. an accessible terminal, pole, pedestal, Feeder Distribution Interface (FDI) or Minimum Point Of Entry (MPOE) including inside wire (owned by Qwest). An accessible terminal is any point on the Loop where technicians can access the wire or fiber within the cable without removing a splice case and/or digging up or trenching underground to reach the wire within.

8.4.1.2 Two (2) types of standard Sub-Loops are available.

- (a) Two-Wire/Four-Wire Unbundled Distribution Loop
- (b) DS1 Capable Unbundled Feeder Loop

8.4.1.3 Sub-Loop Unbundling is only available after a CLEC-requested Field Connection Point (FCP) has been installed at the technically feasible accessible terminal. The FCP provides a demarcation point for the termination of

the Qwest-provided Sub-Loop, and the necessary cross-connections to CLEC-provided facilities. The FCP shall be located in direct proximity to the Qwest Sub-Loop facility accessed by CLEC. The FCP shall be ordered pursuant to the UNE Sub-Loop Unbundling Section herein.

8.4.2 Two-Wire/Four-Wire Unbundled Distribution Loop

8.4.2.1 The Two-Wire/Four-Wire Unbundled Distribution Loop is a Qwest provided facility from the Qwest FCP at the FDI to the demarcation point or Network Interface Device (NID) at the end-user location. The Two-Wire/Four-Wire Unbundled Distribution Loop includes, but is not limited to, distribution facilities that serve Multiple Dwelling Units (MDUs). The Two-Wire/Four-Wire Unbundled Distribution Loop is suitable for local exchange-type services within the analog voice frequency range of 300 to 3000 Hz. CLEC obtains access to this unbundled element at the FDI through an established FCP arrangement, and at the end-user location through the NID.

8.4.3 DS1 Capable Unbundled Feeder Loop

8.4.3.1 DS1 Capable Unbundled Feeder Loop is a digital transmission path that is provisioned from a Qwest Central Office Network Interface, which consists of a DSX-1 panel or equivalent, to the Feeder Distribution Interface (FDI) located at the FCP.

8.4.3.2 The DS1 Capable Unbundled Feeder Loop transports bi-directional DS1 signals with a nominal transmission rate of 1.544 Mbit/s.

8.4.4 Terms and Conditions

8.4.4.1 Access to unbundled loop elements may be made, to the extent technically feasible, through the use of the Field Connection Point Process at any technically feasible Feeder Distribution Interface (FDI) and utility room in a multi-dwelling unit.

8.4.4.2 CLEC obtains access to the DS1 Capable Unbundled Feeder Loop at the Qwest Wire Center through established Collocation arrangements, and at the FDI through the FCP. CLEC must provide the necessary space and meet all premises requirements noted in the technical publication DS1 Capable Sub-Loop.

8.4.4.3 Standard access to a Sub-Loop will be at the Feeder Distribution Interface (FDI) through the establishment of a Field Connection Point (FCP). Non-standard access will be submitted via the BFR process in the Agreement.

8.4.5 Rate Elements

8.4.5.1 Sub-Loop Non-Recurring Charge - CLEC will be charged a non-recurring basic installation charge pursuant to Exhibit A for each Sub-Loop ordered by CLEC.

8.4.5.2 Sub-Loop Recurring Charge - CLEC will be charged a monthly recurring charge pursuant to Exhibit A for each Sub-Loop ordered by CLEC.

8.4.5.3 Sub-Loop OSS Charge - CLEC shall be charged pursuant to Exhibit A to recover the cost of the OSS modifications necessary to provide CLEC access to portions of Qwest's feeder and distribution network facilities on an unbundled, sub-loop basis.

8.4.5.4 Sub-Loop Trouble Isolation Charge - CLEC will be charged a Trouble Isolation Charge pursuant to the Support Functions – Maintenance and Repair Section when trouble is reported but not found on the Qwest facility.

8.4.6 Ordering

8.4.6.1 CLEC may only submit orders for Sub-loop elements after the FCP is in place. CLEC will use the termination information provided at the completion of the FCP on the LSR for Sub-Loops.

8.4.6.2 CLEC can order sub-loop elements through the Operational Support Systems described in the Support Functions Section.

8.4.6.3 CLEC shall identify Sub-loop elements by NC/NCI codes.

8.4.7 Field Connection Point Description

8.4.7.1 Field Connection Point allows CLEC to interconnect with Qwest outside of the central office location where it is technically feasible. Field Connection Point allows CLEC to access Unbundled Sub-Loops. The Field Connection Point must be in place before Sub-Loop orders are processed. Access to FCPs at the FDI are generally available. Requests for other Field Connection Point configurations will be considered on an individual case basis. The only use of the FDI Field Connection Point is to provide access to Qwest Sub Loops.

8.4.7.2 Feeder Distribution Interface (FDI) Field Connection Point – A FDI Field Connection Point arrangement requires CLEC to build and place equipment adjacent to the Qwest FDI location. Qwest will place a cable between the field connection point and Qwest's Feeder Distribution Interface. Qwest will perform the splice at the Field Connection Point. Each Provider will only have access to its own facilities. CLEC will have access to the FCP for maintenance purposes.

8.4.8 Terms and Conditions

8.4.8.1 With the exception specified in subparagraph (a) below, Qwest is not required to build additional space for the purpose of accessing sub-loop elements. Qwest shall not preclude CLEC from constructing its own facilities adjacent to Qwest's facilities. CLEC shall obtain any necessary authorizations or rights of way required and shall coordinate its facility placement with Qwest, when placing their facilities adjacent to Qwest's facilities. Obstacles that CLEC may encounter from cities, counties, electric power companies, property owners and similar third Parties, when it seeks to interconnect its equipment at Sub-loop

access points, will be the responsibility of CLEC to resolve with the municipality, utility, property owner or other third party.

(a) If CLEC seeks access to Two-Wire/Four-Wire Unbundled Distribution Loops that serve an MDU, and there is no accessible MPOE or other accessible terminal to which CLEC can access such Sub-Loop elements, and Qwest and CLEC are unable to negotiate a reconfigured single point of interconnection to serve the MDU, Qwest will construct a single point of access at or near the property line of the MDU that is fully accessible to and suitable for CLEC. In such instance, CLEC shall pay Qwest a nonrecurring charge according to Exhibit A.

8.4.8.2 The optimum point and method to access Sub-Loop elements will be determined during the Field Connection Point process. The Parties agree that they will not have direct access to the other Party's network. The Parties recognize a mutual obligation to interconnect in a manner that maintains network integrity, reliability, and security.

8.4.8.3 If the Parties are unable to reach an agreement on the design of the FCP through the Field Connection Point Process, the Parties may utilize the Dispute Resolution process pursuant to the Terms and Conditions Dispute Resolution Section. Alternatively, CLEC may seek arbitration under Section 252 of the Act with the Commission, wherein Qwest shall have the burden of demonstrating to the Commission that there is insufficient space or that the requested interconnection is not technically feasible.

8.4.8.4 CLEC must identify the size and type of cable that will be terminated in the Qwest FCP location. Qwest will terminate the cable into the Qwest FDI if termination capacity is available. If termination capacity is not available, Qwest will expand the FDI at the request of CLEC. CLEC will be responsible for placing the cable from the Qwest FCP to their equipment. Qwest will perform all of the initial splicing at the FCP.

8.4.8.5 CLEC must arrange for power to its own equipment.

8.4.8.6 If Qwest denies a request for FDI Field Connection Point, Qwest will provide to CLEC documentation stating why the request was denied during the feasibility quote process.

8.4.8.7 CLEC may cancel a Field Connection Point request prior to the completion of the request by Qwest by submitting a written request by certified mail to the Qwest Account Manager. CLEC shall be responsible for payment of all costs incurred by Qwest.

8.4.9 Rate Elements

8.4.9.1 Feeder Distribution Interface Field Connection Point – CLEC will complete a Field Connection Point request form. Qwest will develop a quote for the work to be performed based on the information provided by CLEC on the Request Form. Qwest will recover the Field Connection Point cost through individual case basis non-recurring charges.

8.4.9.2 Feasibility Fee – Qwest will charge a feasibility fee to recover cost of reviewing the site and engineering work that must be completed to determine if a site is available.

8.4.9.3 Quote Preparation Fee - Qwest will charge a fee to recover all cost associated with developing a FDI Field Connection Point quote.

8.4.9.4 Construction Fee – Qwest will charge a fee to recover all cost for building the FDI Field Connection point. This fee will cover the cost of augmenting the FDI location so that three (3) CLECs can interconnect at that point. If CLEC is the first provider in the FDI-FCP, it will pay the quoted price. If CLEC is the second provider in the FDI-FCP, it will pay the initial CLEC 50% of Qwest's quoted price. If CLEC is the third CLEC in the FDI-FCP, it will pay each of the original two (2) CLECs 17% of Qwest's quoted price.

8.4.10 Repair and Maintenance

Qwest will maintain all of its equipment and CLEC is responsible for maintaining all of its equipment.

8.4.11 Ordering – FDI Field Connection Point

8.4.11.1 CLEC shall submit a Field Connection Point Request Form to a Qwest Account Representative. The Field Connection Point Request Form must be completed in its entirety.

8.4.11.2 Upon receipt of the Field Connection Point Request Form, Qwest will initiate a feasibility study and FCP quote. Within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of correctly completed Field Connection Point Request Form, Qwest will notify CLEC if a location is technically feasible and Qwest will develop and send a quote. The Feasibility Study and quote will be valid for thirty (30) calendar days from feasibility and quote notification.

8.4.11.3 Qwest will construct the FCP within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days of receipt of payment from CLEC.

8.4.11.4 After construction is complete, CLEC will be notified of its termination location which will be used for ordering Sub-Loops.
