Certificate of Corridor Compatibility for Transmission Facility

Second Reissued Certificate Number 68

This is to certify that the Commission has designated a transmission facility corridor for Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC to construct a 12-inch diameter crude oil pipeline. The route is described as follows:

approximately 8 miles long within a right-of-way which begins at the applicant's Lignite Station on its existing system near Lignite, North Dakota, traversing Burke County in a northerly direction to the Canadian border approximately 4 miles west of Portal, North Dakota.

The facility may be routed in this designated corridor in compliance with the transmission facility routing criteria. This certificate is reissued in Case No. PU-1984-01-122 and in accordance with the Order of the Commission dated October 18, 1995, in Case No. PU-440-95-145, and is subject to the conditions and limitations noted in the order.
