**ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT AMENDMENT**

**June 6, 2001**

On April 17, 2001, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed an application for approval of a Loop Installation Options Amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with Integra Telecom of North Dakota, Inc. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for unbundled loop installation options.

The agreement was filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under section 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement (or portion thereof) adopted by negotiation if it finds that:

1. the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement;
2. the implementation of the agreement (or portion thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In addition, the Commission may include in its review state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry under section 253.

On April 25, 2001, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments which provided that the Commission would receive written comments on the agreement until May 30, 2001. No comments have been received.

The Commission has reviewed the agreement and does not find that it discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement. The Commission finds that implementation of the agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

**Order**

The Commission orders:

1. The interconnection agreement amendment negotiated between Qwest Corporation and Integra Telecom of North Dakota, Inc. filed with the Commission on April 17, 2001, is APPROVED.



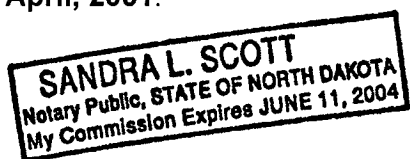



On April 5, 2001, in Case No. PU-2526-01-159, Citizens Telecommunications Company of North Dakota (Citizens) filed an application for approval of an Agreement to Modify and Assume Obligations Under an Interconnection Agreement negotiated with Skyland Technologies, Inc. (Skyland) of Helena, MT. This agreement sets forth rates, terms and conditions under which Citizens agrees to provide services for resale.

On April 9, 2001, in Case No. PU-2528-01-162, Reservation Telephone Cooperative filed an application for approval of a Wireless Interconnection Agreement negotiated with WWC Holding Co., Inc. of Bellevue, WA. This agreement sets forth rates, terms and conditions for wireless interconnection and exchange of traffic.

On April 17, 2001, Qwest Corporation Communications, Inc. (Qwest) filed an application for approval of a Loop Installation Options Amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with Integra Telecom of North Dakota, Inc. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for unbundled loop installation options.

These agreements were filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under section 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement (or portion thereof) adopted by negotiation if it finds that:



1. the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement;
2. the implementation of the agreement (or portion thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In addition, the Commission may include in its review state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry under section 253. Section 252(e)(4) requires that the Commission must act to approve or reject an agreement adopted by negotiation within ninety (90) days after submission by the parties.

**The Commission will receive written comments on these agreements until May 30, 2001.**

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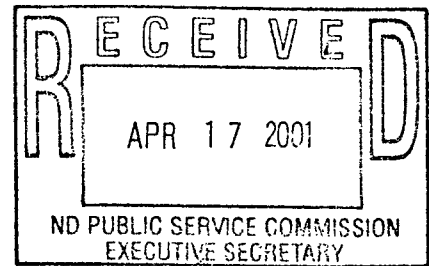

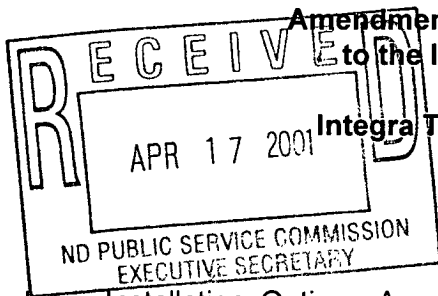

**Amendment re: Loop Installation Options

This Loop Installation Options Amendment ("Amendment") is entered into by and between Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), a Colorado corporation, and Integra Telecom of North Dakota, Inc. ("CLEC"). This Agreement may refer to Qwest or to CLEC as a party ("Party") to this Agreement. The service(s) described in this Agreement shall be provided in the state of North Dakota.

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, CLEC and Qwest entered into an Interconnection Agreement, for service in the state of North Dakota, that was approved by the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") on September 29, 1997, in Case No. PU-1753-97-532 (the "Agreement"); and;

WHEREAS, CLEC and Qwest wish to amend the Agreement by adding the terms, conditions and rates contained herein.

**AGREEMENT**

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

**1. Amendment Terms**

This Amendment is made in order to add the terms, conditions and rates for Unbundled Loop Installation Options in Attachment 1 and Exhibit A to this Amendment, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**2. Effective Date**

This Amendment shall be deemed effective upon Commission approval; however, the Parties may agree to implement the provisions of this Amendment upon execution. To accommodate this need, Integra must generate, if necessary, an updated Customer Questionnaire. In addition to the Questionnaire, all system updates will need to be completed by Qwest. Integra will be notified when all system changes have been made. Actual order processing may begin once these requirements have been met.

**3. Further Amendments**

Except as modified herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. Neither the Agreement nor this Amendment may be further amended or altered except by written instrument executed by an authorized representative of both Parties.

The Parties intending to be legally bound have executed this Amendment as of the dates set forth below, in multiple counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.

1.1 Five provisioning options are available for Unbundled Loop elements. The charge for these provisioning options will vary depending on the type of loop requested and the negotiated contract rate.

- Basic Installation
- Basic Installation with Performance Testing
- Basic Installation with Cooperative Testing
- Coordinated Installation with Cooperative Testing
- Coordinated Installation without Cooperative Testing

1.2 Refer to Qwest's Technical Publication 77384 Issue G, for the testing parameters.

### 1.3 Basic Installation

The Basic Installation may be ordered for new or existing unbundled loops.

For an existing end-user, the Basic Installation option is a "lift and lay" procedure. The Central Office Technician (COT) "lifts" the loop from its current termination and "lays" it on a new termination connecting to CLEC.

For new end-user service, the Basic Installation option involves the COT and Field Technician (CST/NT) completing circuit wiring and performing the required performance tests to ensure the new circuit meets the required parameter limits. The test results are NOT provided to CLEC.

#### Ordering Requirements

Basic is assumed unless the CHC and APPTIME fields are completed or Basic with Testing is noted in the Remarks section of the LSR.

### 1.4 Basic Installation with Performance Testing

The Basic Installation with Performance Testing option may be ordered for new or existing unbundled loops.

For an existing end-user, the Basic Installation with Performance Testing option is a "lift and lay" procedure. The Central Office Technician (COT) "lifts" the loop from its current termination and "lays" it on a new termination connecting to CLEC. The COT and Implementor/Tester perform the required performance tests to ensure the new circuit meets the required parameter limits. These test results are read to CLEC by the Qwest Implementor/Tester on close-out.

For new end-user service, the Basic Installation with Performance Testing option requires a dispatch to the end-user premise. The COT and Field Technician (CST/NT) complete circuit wiring and perform the required performance tests to ensure the new circuit meets the required parameter limits. These test results are read to CLEC by the Qwest

Implementor/Tester on close-out.

Ordering Requirements:

CHC = 'N' or Blank

TEST = A (for Performance Testing)

#### 1.5 Basic Installation with Cooperative Testing

The Basic Installation with Cooperative Testing option may be ordered for new or existing unbundled loops.

For an existing end-user, the Basic Installation with Cooperative Testing option is a "lift and lay" procedure with Cooperative Testing on the Due Date. The Central Office Technician (COT) "lifts" the loop from its current termination and "lays" it on a new termination connecting to CLEC. CLEC will be contacted to perform a loop back acceptance test, accept the loop and exchange demarcation information. Any required test results are read to CLEC by the Qwest Implementor/Tester on close-out.

For new end-user service, the Basic Installation with Cooperative Testing option requires a dispatch to the end-user premise. The COT and Field Technician (CST/NT) complete circuit wiring and perform the required performance tests to ensure the new circuit meets the required parameter limits. These test results are read to CLEC by the Qwest Implementor/Tester on close-out. CLEC will be contacted on the due date to perform a loop back acceptance test, accept the loop, and exchange demarcation information.

Ordering Requirements:

CHC = 'N' or Blank

TEST = B (for Cooperative Testing)

**NOTE: This Option is not available in Iowa, Colorado and Oregon.**

#### 1.6 Coordinated Installation with Cooperative Testing

The Coordinated Installation with Cooperative Testing option may be ordered for new or existing service.

For an existing end-user, the Coordinated Installation with Cooperative Testing option is a "lift and lay" procedure with Cooperative Testing. CLEC must designate a specific "Appointment Time" when the LSR is submitted. On the Due Date (DD), at CLEC designated "Appointment Time", the Qwest Implementor /Tester contacts CLEC to ensure CLEC is ready for the Installation. The COT completes the installation in the CO. Tests requested by CLEC will be performed at this time. Any required test results are read to CLEC by the Qwest Implementor/Tester on close-out. It is important to note that any CLEC requested Unbundled Loop provisioning test not defined in the Qwest Technical Publication 77384 is billable.

For new end-user service, the Coordinated Installation with Cooperative Testing option requires a dispatch to the end-user premise. CLEC may elect to specify that no Dispatch is

requested. This will signal Qwest that the Field Technician (CST/NT) will not need to stay on the premise to perform the Coordinated Installation once the circuit is in place. CLEC must designate a specific "Appointment Time" when the LSR is submitted. On the Due Date (DD), at the CLEC designated "Appointment Time", the Qwest Implementor /Tester contacts CLEC to ensure CLEC is ready for the Installation. The COT and Field Technician (CST/NT) complete circuit wiring and perform the required performance tests to ensure the new circuit meets the required parameter limits. These test results are read to CLEC by the Qwest Implementor/Tester on close-out. Additional tests requested by CLEC will be performed at this time. It is important to note that any CLEC requested Unbundled Loop provisioning test not defined in the Qwest Technical Publication 77384 is billable.

TEST = B (for Cooperative testing)

### 1.7 Coordinated Installation without Cooperative Testing

The Coordinated Installation without Cooperative Testing option may be ordered for new or existing service.

For an existing unbundled loop this option remains a "lift and lay" procedure (no Premise Dispatch required) but offers CLEC the ability to coordinate the conversion activity.

<p><b>NOTE: This Option is not available in Iowa and Colorado.</b></p>
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CLEC must designate a specific "Appointment Time" when the LSR is submitted. On the Due Date (DD), at the CLEC designated "Appointment Time", the Implementor/Tester will contact CLEC to notify CLEC that the work activity is beginning. Once the work has been completed, the Qwest Implementor advises CLEC that the "lift and lay" procedure has been completed.

For new unbundled loops, a dispatch may be required to 'tie-down' the new circuit at the Customer Premise. CLEC may elect to specify that no Dispatch is requested. This will signal Qwest that the Field Technician (CST/NT) will not need to stay on the premise to perform the Coordinated Installation once the circuit is in place. CLEC must designate a specific "Appointment Time" when the LSR is submitted. On the Due Date (DD), at the CLEC designated "Appointment Time", after the circuit is in place, the Qwest Implementor /Tester contacts CLEC to ensure CLEC is ready for the installation. The COT completes the installation in the CO. The COT and Implementor/Tester complete the required Performance Tests to ensure the new circuit meets the required parameter limits. The test results are NOT provided to CLEC. CLEC is verbally advised that the Installation is complete.
