



ORDER

August 8, 2001

On June 1, 2001, in Case No. PU-2516-01-287, Qwest filed an application for approval of an 8XX Database Query Service Amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with Skyland Technologies, Inc. of Helena, MT. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for 8XX Database Query Service.

On June 11, 2001, in Case No. PU-2445-01-303, Qwest filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement negotiated with New Access Communications, LLC. On June 18, 2001, in Case No. PU-2568-01-314, Qwest filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement negotiated with Z-Tel Communications, Inc. These agreements set forth rates, terms and conditions for interconnection of facilities, including unbundled network elements, ancillary services and services for resale.

Also on June 11, 2002, in Case No. PU-2057-01-304, Qwest filed an application for an Amendment regarding Single Point of Presence negotiated to its interconnection agreement with McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. On June 13, 2001, in Case No. PU-2565-01-306, Qwest filed a similar amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with HTC Services, Inc. These amendments incorporate terms and conditions for Qwest's Single Point of Presence service.

These agreements were filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under section 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement (or portion thereof) adopted by negotiation if it finds that:

1. the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement;
2. the implementation of the agreement (or portion thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In addition, the Commission may include in its review state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry under section 253.

On June 27, 2001, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments, which provided that the Commission would receive written comments on the agreement until July 31, 2001. No comments have been received.


The Commission has reviewed the agreements and does not find them discriminatory against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreements. The Commission finds that implementation of the agreements is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.


Order

The Commission orders:

1. The captioned interconnection agreements and amendments are APPROVED.
2. The Commission retains continuing jurisdiction over the agreements at all times.
3. Notice of any changes to the agreements must be filed promptly with the Commission.
4. The agreements must not be assigned, assumed or otherwise transferred without the approval of the Commission.

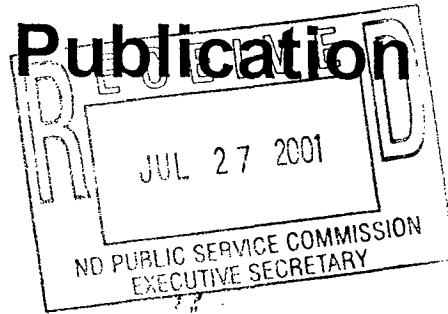


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

On June 1, 2001, in Case No. PU-2516-01-287, Qwest filed an application for approval of an 8XX Database Query Service Amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with Skyland Technologies, Inc. of Helena, MT. This amendment sets forth rates, terms and conditions for 8XX Database Query Service.

On June 11, 2001, in Case No. PU-2445-01-303, Qwest filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement negotiated with New Access Communications, LLC. On June 18, 2001, in Case No. PU-2568-01-314, Qwest filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement negotiated with Z-Tel Communications, Inc. These agreements set forth rates, terms and conditions for interconnection of facilities, including unbundled network elements, ancillary services and services for resale.

Also on June 11, 2002, in Case No. PU-2057-01-304, Qwest filed an application for an Amendment regarding Single Point of Presence negotiated to its interconnection agreement with McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. On June 13, 2001, in Case No. PU-2565-01-306, Qwest filed a similar amendment negotiated to its interconnection agreement with HTC Services, Inc. These amendments incorporate terms and conditions for Qwest's Single Point of Presence service.

These agreements were filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under section 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement (or portion thereof) adopted by negotiation if it finds that:

1. the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement;
2. the implementation of the agreement (or portion thereof) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

In addition, the Commission may include in its review state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry under section 253. Section 252(e)(4) requires that the Commission must act to approve or reject an agreement adopted by negotiation within ninety (90) days after submission by the parties.

The Commission will receive written comments on these agreements until July 31, 2001.

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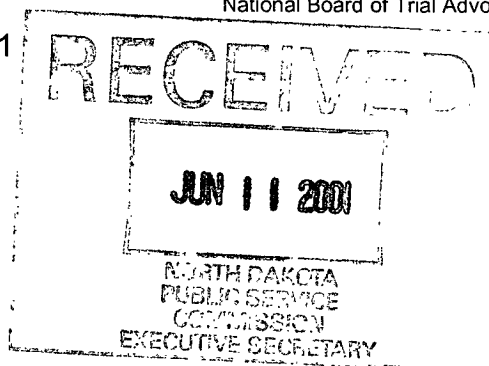

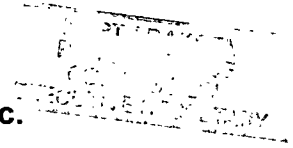

This Amendment to the Local Interconnection Agreement is between McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("CLEC"), an Iowa corporation, and Qwest Corporation (f/k/a U S WEST Communications, Inc.) ("Qwest"), a Colorado corporation. CLEC and Qwest shall be known jointly as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interconnection Agreement that was approved by the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") on May 26, 1999, Docket/Order No. PU-2057-99-109 23 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement under the terms and conditions contained herein.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Amendment Terms.

This Amendment is made in order to add terms and conditions for Single Point of Presence (SPOP) in the LATA, to the Agreement, as set forth in Attachment 1 and Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

2. Effective Date.

This Amendment shall be deemed effective upon Commission approval; however, the Parties may agree to implement the provisions of this Amendment upon execution.

3. Further Amendments.

Except as modified herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. Neither the Agreement nor this Amendment may be further amended or altered except by written instrument executed by an authorized representative of both Parties.

The Parties intending to be legally bound have executed this Amendment as of the dates set forth below, in multiple counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.



ATTACHMENT 1

Single Point of Presence (SPOP) in the LATA is a Local Interconnection Service (LIS)/Type 2 Interconnection trunking option that allows CLEC/WSP to establish one physical point of presence in the LATA in Qwest's territory. Qwest and CLEC may then exchange traffic at the SPOP utilizing trunking as described following.

- 1.1 By utilizing SPOP in the LATA, CLEC/WSP can deliver both Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll Non-IXC) and Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA IXC) traffic and Exchange Service EAS/Local traffic at Qwest's Access Tandem Switches. CLEC/WSP can also utilize Qwest's behind the tandem infrastructure to terminate traffic to specific end offices. The SPOP is defined as the CLEC/WSP's physical point of presence.
- 1.2 SPOP in the LATA includes an Entrance Facility (EF)/Expanded Interconnect Channel Termination (EICT) and Direct Trunked Transport (DTT) options at both a DS1 and DS3 capacity.
- 1.3 Where there is a Qwest local tandem serving an end office that CLEC/WSP intends to terminate traffic, the following conditions apply:
 - 1.3.1 All local trunking must be ordered to the Qwest local tandem for the Qwest end office served by the Qwest local tandem, subject to the 512 CCS rules.
 - 1.3.2 Connections to a Qwest local tandem may be two-way or one-way trunks. These trunks will carry Exchange Service EAS/Local traffic only.
 - 1.3.3 A separate trunk group to the Qwest access tandem is required for the exchange of Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll Non-IXC) traffic and Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA IXC) traffic. CLEC/WSP may, at its option, elect to separate its Exchange Access and Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic onto two separate trunk groups, each going to the Qwest access tandem.
- 1.4 Where there is no Qwest local tandem serving a Qwest end office, CLEC/WSP may choose from one of the following options:
 - 1.4.1 A two-way CLEC/WSP LIS/Type 2 trunk group to the Qwest access tandem for CLEC/WSP traffic terminating to, originating from, or passing through the Qwest network that combines Exchange Service EAS/ Local, Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll Non-IXC) and Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA IXC) traffic. If CLEC/WSP selects this option, Qwest will send Exchange Service EAS/Local, Exchange Access and Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic to CLEC on the same two-way LIS/Type 2 trunk group.
 - 1.4.2 A two-way CLEC/WSP LIS/Type 2 trunk group to the Qwest access tandem for CLEC/WSP Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA IXC) traffic terminating to and originating from the IXC Feature Group (FG) A/B/D

network through the Qwest network and an additional two-way trunk group to the Qwest access tandem for the combined Exchange Service EAS/ Local and Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll Non-IXC) traffic terminating to, originating from, and transiting the Qwest network. IF CLEC/WSP selects this option, Qwest will send traffic to CLEC/WSP under the same configuration: (1) Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic on the first two-way trunk group and (2) combined Exchange Service EAS/Local and Exchange Access traffic on the second two-way trunk group.

1.4.3 A one-way terminating CLEC/WSP LIS/Type 2 trunk group to the Qwest access tandem for CLEC/WSP traffic destined to or through the Qwest network that combines Exchange Service EAS/Local, Exchange Access (Intra LATA Toll Non-IXC) and Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA IXC) traffic. If CLEC/WSP selects this option, Qwest will send Exchange Service EAS/Local, Exchange Access and Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic to CLEC/WSP on a single one-way LIS/Type 2 trunk group.

1.4.4 CLEC/WSP may utilize a one-way LIS/Type 2 trunk group to the Qwest access tandem for Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA IXC) traffic terminating to the IXC FG A/B/D network through the Qwest network, and an additional one-way trunk group to the Qwest access tandem for the combined Exchange Service EAS/ Local, Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll Non-IXC) traffic terminating to, originating from, and transiting the Qwest network. If CLEC/WSP selects this option, Qwest will send traffic to CLEC/WSP under the same configuration: (1) Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic on one one-way trunk group and (2) Exchange Service EAS/Local and Exchange Access traffic on the second one-way trunk group.

1.4.4.1 LATA Toll Non-IXC) trunk group.

1.4.5 To the extent Qwest combines Exchange Service (EAS/Local), Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll carried solely by Local Exchange Carriers), and Jointly Provided Switched Access (InterLATA and IntraLATA calls exchanged with a third-party IXC) traffic on a single LIS/Type 2 trunk group, Qwest, at CLEC/WSP's request, will declare a percent local use factor (PLU). Such PLU(s) will be verifiable with either call summary records utilizing Calling Party Number information for jurisdictionalization or call detail samples. CLEC/WSP should apportion per minute of use (MOU) charges appropriately.

1.5 CLEC/WSP must have SS7 functionality to use SPOP in the LATA.

1.6 Qwest assumes CLEC/WSP will be originating Exchange Access (IntraLATA Toll Non-IXC) traffic, therefore, CLEC/WSP must order LIS/Type 2 trunking to each Qwest access tandem in the LATA to accommodate routing of this traffic. Additionally, if there is more than one Qwest access tandem within the LATA boundary, the CLEC/WSP must order LIS/Type 2 trunking to each Qwest access tandem that serves its end-user customers' traffic to avoid call blocking. Alternatively, should the CLEC/WSP accept the conditions as outlined in the SPOP Waiver (Exhibit A), trunking will not be required to each Qwest access tandem in a multi-access tandem LATA.

- 1.7 CLEC/WSP only needs trunking to each local tandem where they have a customer base. The 512 CCS rule and other direct trunking requirements will apply for direct trunking to Qwest end offices.
- 1.8 If Direct Trunked Transport is greater than 50 miles in length, and existing facilities are not available in either Party's network, and the Parties cannot agree as to which Party will provide the facility, the Parties will construct facilities to a mid-point of the span.
- 1.9 SPOP in the LATA cannot be used in conjunction with existing CLEC/WSP LIS/Type 2 trunking that connects to Qwest's end office switches with tandem functionality.
- 1.10 The LIS/Type 2 SPOP facility cannot be used to access unbundled network elements.
- 1.11 Ordering
 - 1.11.1 SPOP in a LATA will be ordered based upon the standard ordering process for the type of facility chosen. See the Qwest Interconnection and Resale Resource Guide for further ordering information.

EXHIBIT A**SINGLE POINT OF PRESENCE WAIVER**

Qwest will waive the requirement for CLEC/WSP to connect to each Qwest Access Tandem in the LATA with this waiver amendment.

CLEC/WSP certifies that it will not originate any Exchange Access or Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic destined for subtending offices of Qwest Access Tandems for which CLEC/WSP seeks a waiver. Or, if CLEC/WSP does originate such traffic, that CLEC/WSP will route such traffic to an Interexchange Carrier network. In addition, CLEC/WSP certifies that it has no end users in the serving area of the Qwest Access Tandem for which CLEC/WSP seeks a waiver.

CLEC/WSP will notify Qwest of the Qwest access tandems subject to this waiver at the time of ordering trunks required to implement SPOP in the LATA. CLEC/WSP will provide thirty (30) days written notice to Qwest advising of any changes in the network configuration of the aforementioned access tandems. Should CLEC desire to begin serving end users in the serving area of a Qwest access tandem currently under this waiver, CLEC must first establish trunking to the Qwest access tandem. Additionally, should CLEC desire to originate traffic destined to a Qwest end office subtending a Qwest access tandem currently under this waiver, CLEC must first establish trunking to the Qwest access tandem.

Under this waiver any incorrectly routed Exchange Access and Jointly Provided Switched Access traffic will be billed separately, by Qwest to CLEC/WSP, via a manual bill.

Misrouted usage will be billed, per MOU, based on Qwest's retail direct dial Message Telecommunication Service (MTS) rates, as follows:
