Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Reservation Telephone Cooperative, (SAC# 381632), and pursuant to Section 54.315 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and in accordance with FCC Docket No. 96-45, please accept this correspondence as official notification Reservation Telephone Cooperative's election of a disaggregation path regarding its federal high cost universal service support.

Specifically, Reservation Telephone Cooperative elects the disaggregation option provided for in Section 54.315(b) and commonly referred to as "Path 1". As such, Reservation Telephone Cooperative is choosing to certify to the Commission that it is not disaggregating and targeting its high cost support at this time.

This election will remain in place for four years from the effective date of certification, pursuant to Section 54.315, unless the FCC, on its own motion, or upon the motion of Reservation Telephone Cooperative or an interested party, requires a change to the elected disaggregation plan.
