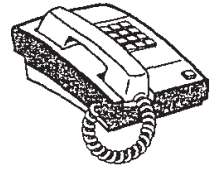

RE: Selection of a Path for Disaggregation of Federal High Cost Universal Service Support

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Inter-Community Telephone Company, (SAC# 381616), and pursuant to Section 54.315 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and in accordance with FCC Docket No. 96-45, please accept this correspondence as official notification Inter-Community Telephone Company's election of a disaggregation path regarding its federal high cost universal service support.

Specifically, Inter-Community Telephone Company elects the disaggregation option provided for in Section 54.315(b) and commonly referred to as "Path 1". As such, Inter-Community Telephone Company is choosing to certify to the Commission that it is not disaggregating and targeting its high cost support at this time.

This election will remain in place for four years from the effective date of certification, pursuant to Section 54.315, unless the FCC, on its own motion, or upon the motion of Inter-Community Telephone Company or an interested party, requires a change to the elected disaggregation plan.
