AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF COVAD COMMUNICATIONS COMPANY

Charles J. McMinn and Dhruv Khanna certify that:

1. They are the President and Secretary, respectively, of Covad Communications Company, a California corporation.
2. The Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation are hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation is Covad Communications Company.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose of this Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the General Corporation Law of California other than the banking business, the trust company business or the practice of a profession permitted to be incorporated by the California Corporations Code.

ARTICLE III.

The Corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares to be designated Common Stock. The total number of shares of Common Stock the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 4,000.

Immediately upon the filing of this Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, each one thousand (1,000) outstanding shares of the Company's Common Stock will be exchanged and combined, automatically and without further action, into one (1) share of Common Stock. Such combination shall be rounded up to the nearest whole share.

ARTICLE IV.

Section 1. Limitation of Director's Liability. The liability of members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation for monetary damages shall be eliminated to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

Section 2. Indemnification of Corporation Agents. The corporation is authorized to provide indemnification of agents (as defined in Section 317 of the California Corporations Code) to the fullest extent permissible under California law.

Section 3. Repeal or Modification. Any amendment, repeal or modification of any provision of this Article IV shall not adversely affect any right or protection of an agent of this corporation existing at the time of such amendment, repeal or modification."

3. The foregoing amendment and restatement of Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.

4. The foregoing amendment and restatement of Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the required vote of shareholders of the Corporation in accordance with Sections 902 and 903 of the California Corporations Code. The total number of outstanding shares of Common Stock of the Corporation is 3,494,568. The number of shares voting in favor of the amendment equaled or exceeded the vote required. The percentage vote required was 100% of the outstanding shares of Common Stock.



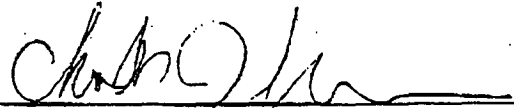

APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

OF

(Pursuant to Section 1304 of the Business Corporation Law)

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Covad Communications Company. The corporation shall use the name Covad Communications Company in the State of New York.
