Dear Ms. Jeffcoat-Sacco:

At the hearing of the above-captioned matters, members of the North Dakota Public Service Commission and staff raised several inquiries relative to PPM Energy, Inc.'s plans for the specific sites of its wind turbines at the proposed Rugby Wind Farm. At that time, specific sites had not yet been formalized but representatives of PPM indicated that when the same were completed, a "site plan" would be submitted to the Commission. In accordance with that testimony by PPM, please find enclosed herewith an original and ten copies of PPM's wind turbine and road layout for the proposed 150 MW wind project. The proposed layout utilizes 100 1.5 MW wind turbines. PPM has, identified as set forth in the site layout, alternate sites that will be utilized for wind turbines and roads in the event that the preferred sites are proven to be unsuitable prior to construction. The attached layout is consistent with the setbacks proposed by PPM at the hearing.

The Commission will no doubt recall that PPM had initially contemplated placing a wind turbine approximately 1400 feet from the residence of Mr. and Mrs. J. T. McIntire. In the plan being submitted herewith, PPM has eliminated wind turbine from its final layout. As such, the closest wind turbine to the McIntire's residence is approximately 3,500 feet or approximately one-half mile. By copy of this letter, PPM has forwarded this "site plan" to the McIntires.


PPM has plans to commence construction of the roads and foundations as early as October 1, 2005. Accordingly, if the Commission deems it necessary to hold an informal hearing or work session to consider PPM's "site plan", PPM respectfully requests the Commission to do so along a time schedule which will allow the hearing or work session to be properly noticed, and held and still

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allow the Commission to render a decision approving the "site plan" on or before September 30, 2005
