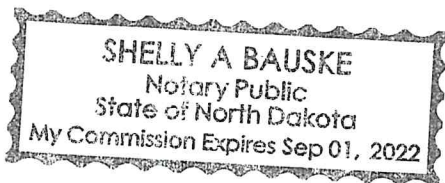

NOTICE OF HEARING

November 17, 2021

A **Public Hearing** on the application in the case enumerated above will begin **Friday, December 17, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. central time, in the Commission Hearing Room, 12th Floor, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505.**

On November 2, 2021, Rugby Wind, LLC (Rugby) filed with the Commission a request for an extension of time to equip the Rugby Wind Farm energy conversion facility with a functioning light-mitigating technology system. Light-mitigating technology system means aircraft detection lighting system, lighting intensity dimming solution technology, or a comparable solution capable of reducing the impact of nighttime lighting while maintaining night conspicuity sufficient to assist aircraft in identifying and avoiding collision with the facilities. Rugby requests an extension of the statutory deadline from December 31, 2021, to May 31, 2022.

The issue to be considered in this proceeding is whether an extension of time should be granted based on technical or economic feasibility considerations.
