Dear Mr. Fahn:

Enclosed is a report presenting woody vegetation quantification and replanting for Public Service Commission order No. PU-05-184 for pipeline construction in Richland County, ND.

This report indicates the quantity and type of trees and shrubs destroyed and replaced on a 2:1 basis during construction in each of the two areas covered under the orders stated above. The shrubs consisted primarily of buffalo berry bushes and Russian olive or ash trees.

Replacement trees and shrubs were replaced in accordance with landowner wishes and an option of plastic weed protection fabric was offered at the landowner discretion. A report of tree and shrub survival will be submitted prior to October 1 for the next three years.



150 shrubs and 5 trees were destroyed in the construction of pipeline on this project. Several areas where woody vegetation existed were bored under.

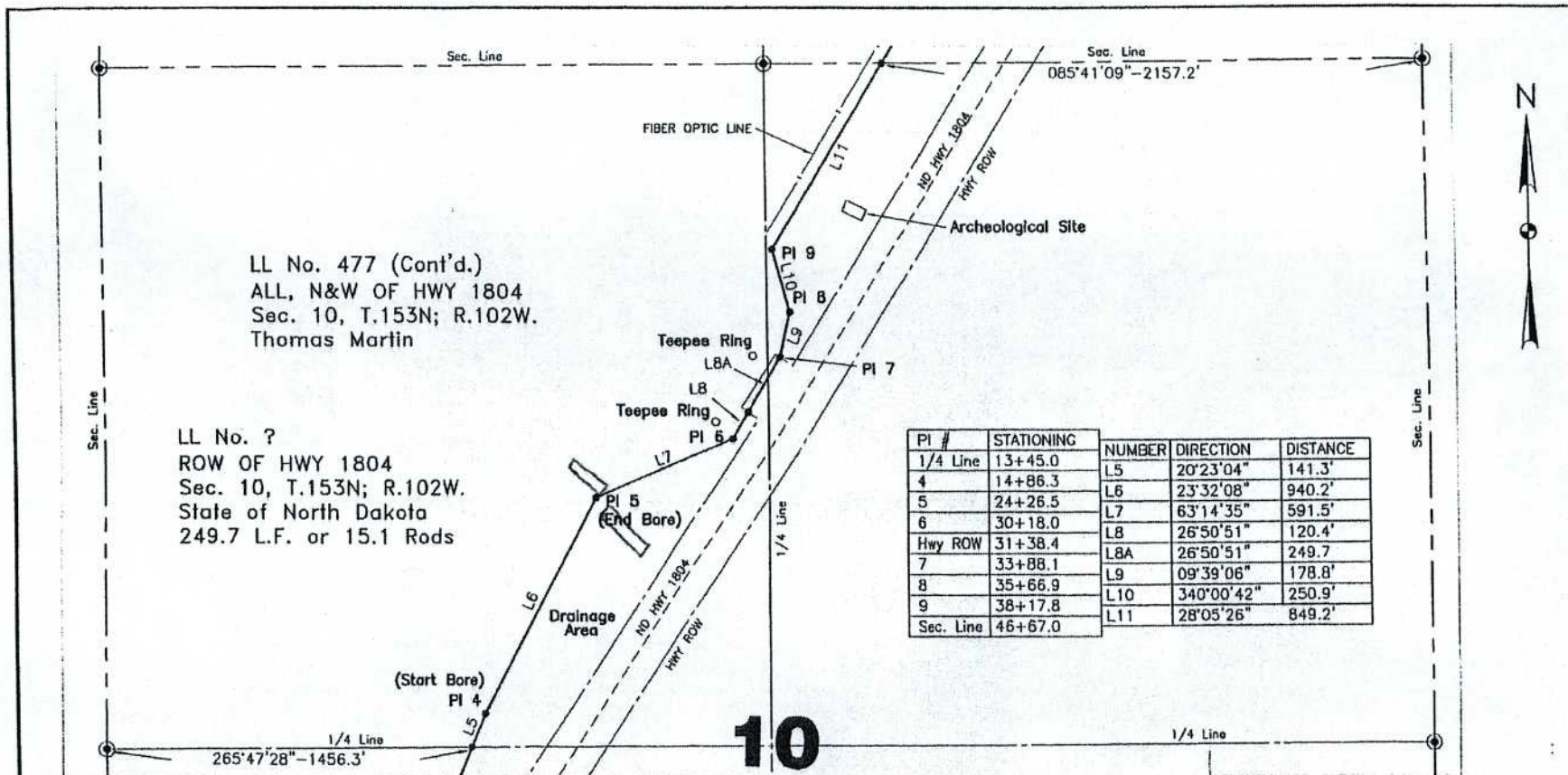

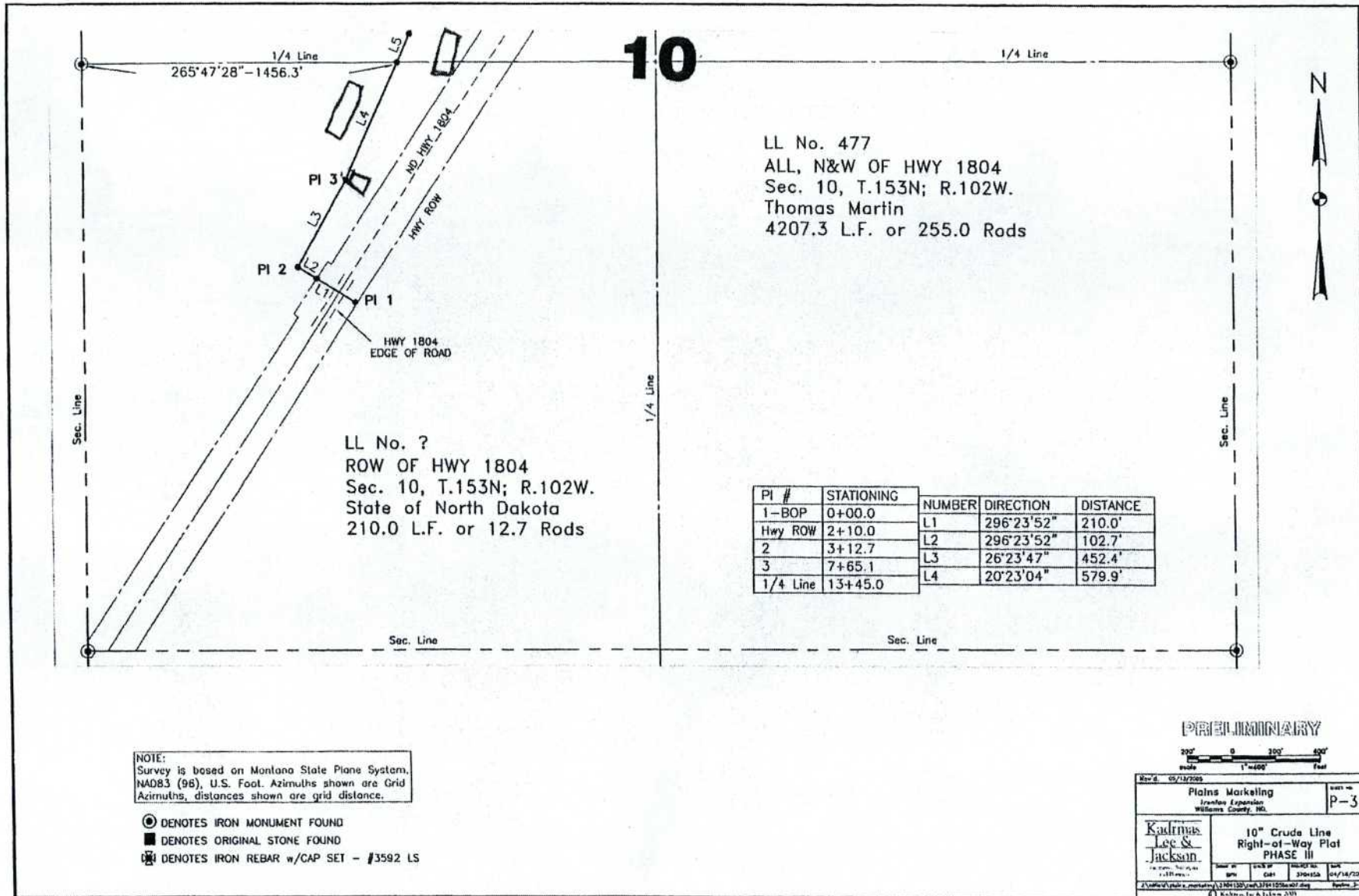

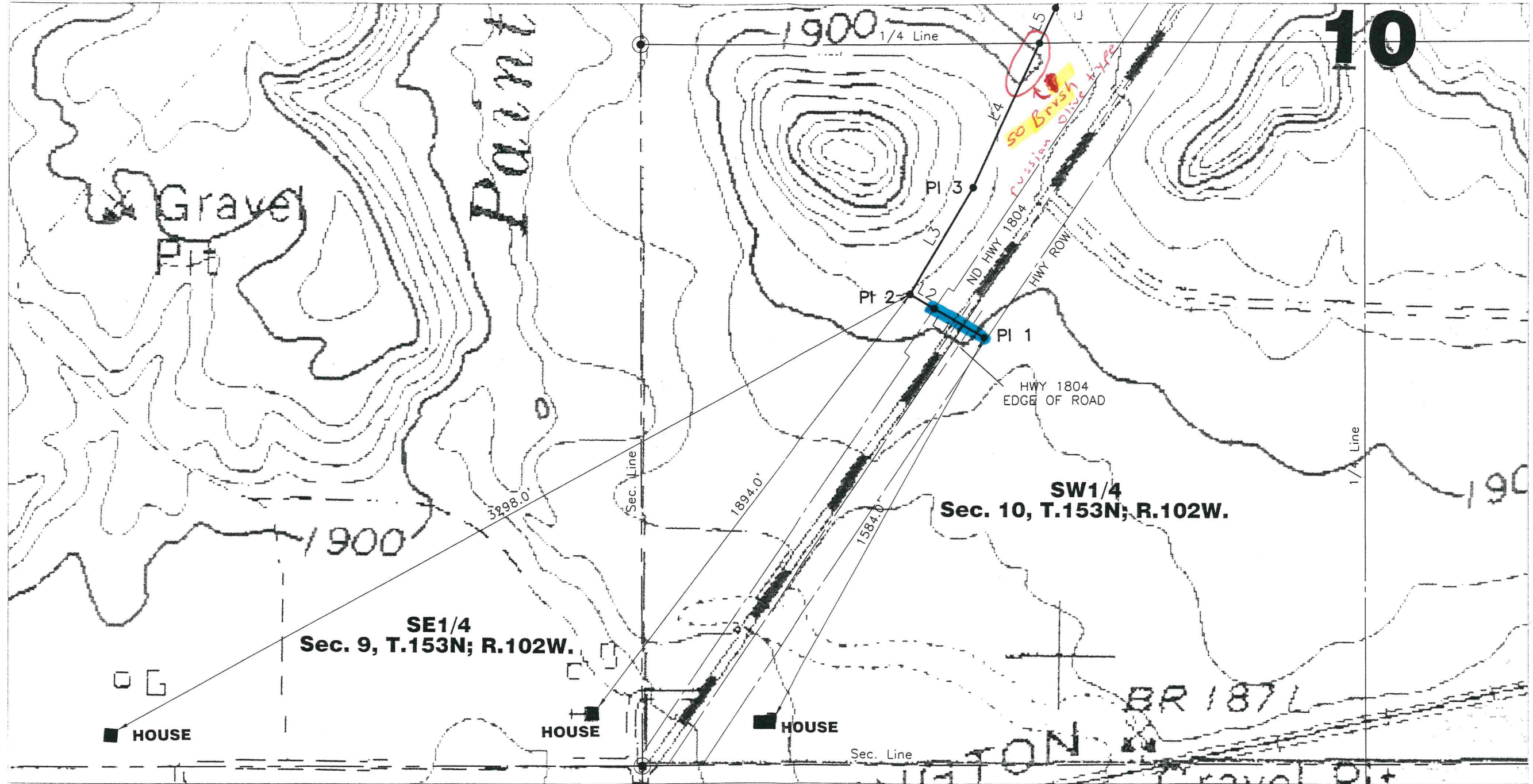
10" Crude Line
