This is to certify that the Commission has designated a transmission facility corridor for Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s crude oil transmission line described as:

A corridor approximately 2 miles wide that begins approximately 11 miles southwest of the city of Williston in Section 30, Township 152 North, Range 104 West, McKenzie County, at the Montana/North Dakota border and extends northeast approximately 2.75 miles to the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 152 North, Range 104 West, Williams County, just south of the Fort Buford Historic Site.


