NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING

December 30, 2005

On September 29, 2005, Capital Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Complainant) filed a Complaint alleging that Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Respondent) (1) intends to provide electrical service to a development in Complainant's service area and (2) such service will unreasonably interfere or is about to unreasonably interfere with the service or system of Complainant.


The Commission scheduled a hearing for December 13, 2005. On November 30, 2005 that hearing was continued.


A **public hearing** on this matter has been rescheduled for **February 9, 2006 beginning at 9 a.m. CST** in the Commission hearing room, State Capitol, 12th Floor, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505. Issues to be considered in this matter include:

1. Whether the Public Service Commission has jurisdiction to award the relief requested by the Complainant.
2. Whether Respondent should be restrained and enjoined from constructing or extending its lines, plant, or system into Complainant's franchised service area.
3. Whether Respondent should remove all of its facilities in the Complainant's service area.
