

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION INFORMATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

## **Informal Hearing Regarding Billing of Vacant Rental Property Tariff**

Xcel Energy has filed a proposal with the North Dakota Public Service Commission regarding the tenant change process for utility service in residential rental units.

Under the options in the *Residential Billing of Vacant Rental Property* (BVRP) proposal, landlords must choose between paying bills for gas and electric service while an apartment is vacant or paying new disconnect and reconnect fees of up to \$20 each for electricity service and a new disconnect fee of up to \$40 and a new reconnect fee of up to \$65 for natural gas service.
