SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ON MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

November 16, 2007

On October 18, 2007, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. ("Montana-Dakota") filed a motion for continuance of the hearings in these cases pursuant to N.D. Admin. Code §69-02-04-03.

At a special meeting held on November 9, 2007, the Public Service Commission denied the motion for continuance in Case No. PU-06-278.

On November 14, 2007, the Commission received a letter from Capital Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Capital Electric") advising the Commission that based on progress in negotiations to produce a new area service agreement, Capital Electric joins Montana-Dakota in its request that the hearing scheduled for November 19, 2007 be continued. Montana-Dakota sent an e-mail message on November 14, 2007 concurring with the request filed by Capital Electric.

The Commission has authority to issue a continuance. North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-02-04-03 provides that a motion for a continuance can be made after a hearing is scheduled for good cause.




Therefore, the Commission makes its:
