Patrick,

I have discussed your request for GIS map data with the Enbridge. As I mentioned in my voicemail late last week, there is a homeland security issue in that pipeline companies have been requested not to post on the internet electronic versions of pipeline locations. According to Enbridge's legal department, it would be okay to give electronic maps to the PSC if the PSC makes a written request for such electronic maps for the public record and acknowledges in the written request that such electronic maps will only be used internally and not posted on the PSC website or otherwise distributed in any manner. The environmental department has requested that this stipulation also be applied to all the other electronic map data, not just the pipeline locations.
