


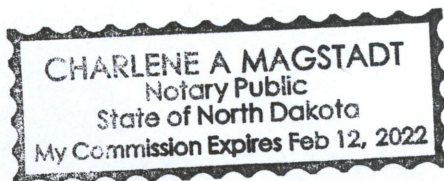

**ORDER ON PROTECTION OF INFORMATION**

**May 18, 2016**

On September 28, 2015, North Dakota Pipe Line Company, LLC (NDPL) filed an application to protect confidential critical energy infrastructure information, asserting the information is exempt from N.D.C.C. § 44-04-18.

North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-02-09-01(4) requires the Company to provide the basis upon which the information qualifies for protection of information. NDPL stated that the information contained on a CD and labeled "CRITICAL ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE INFORMATION – CONFIDENTIAL" is protected critical energy infrastructure and is entitled to nondisclosure as Critical Energy Infrastructure Information under federal guidelines. Enbridge further asserts the information qualifies as being exempt from public disclosure pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 44-04-24.


N.D. Admin. Code § 69-02-09-03 states that the "commission staff shall examine the information and application, and file and serve a response that includes a recommendation on whether the information qualifies for protection." Commission Staff has reviewed the request.

The Commission's process provides a means for interested parties to review protected documents upon signing a nondisclosure agreement. Having reviewed NDPL's application and Commission Staff's recommendation, the Commission has determined that the information satisfies the requirements of North Dakota Century Code for protection of information.


**Order**

The Commission orders the application of North Dakota Pipeline Company, LLC for Protection of Information is GRANTED.
