Keystone has filed two motions with the Commission. The first is a Motion for Approval of Reroutes. There are 49 requests for reroute or variances to the location of the route and locations of valves and pumps along the route. Because of the volume of requests, staff has prepared a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing and a Notice of Informal Hearing for the reroute motion. Comments would be due by May 19<sup>th</sup> and the informal hearing would be May 21<sup>st</sup>.

Keystone's second motion is for approval of the tree and shrub sampling plan, approval of stream crossing methods, clarification of inconsistency on tree clearing widths, and approval of extra work space in forested areas. Staff recommends that these matters can be addressed through an informal hearing on May 7<sup>th</sup>, and that no notice of opportunity for hearing is necessary.
