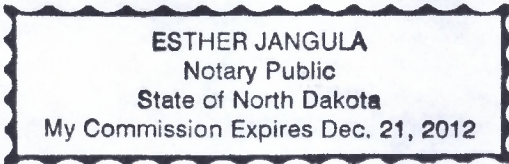

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING AND
NOTICE OF INFORMAL HEARING**

April 16, 2008

On April 7, 2008 TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP (Keystone) filed a Motion for Approval of Reroutes. The reroutes are identified and maps are attached to the application.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed pipeline facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed pipeline facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed pipeline facilities locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?



Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearings must be received by **May 19, 2008**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.




