Hi Pat:

I wanted to give you the information on the project's Supervisor Level Environmental Training Program.

Mainline construction on Spreads 1A and 2A of the Keystone Project is scheduled to begin on May 19, 2008.

In preparation for the start of this work, Keystone is planning to hold Supervisor-Level Environmental Training Programs for Spreads 1A and 2A on May 15 and May 16, respectively. We would welcome your attendance and participation at the training(s) if you would like to attend. If you decide to attend, we will provide you an opportunity to communicate issues of importance to you and your agency during construction of the project.

Spread 1A extends from Keystone MP 0 to 129.9 (all in ND)

Spread 2A extends from Keystone MP 129.9 to 217.7 in ND and MP 217.7 to approximately MP 264 in northern SD

Please let me know if you plan to attend one or both of these training sessions and we will provide you with more information. **Please RSVP by Friday, May 9, 2008.**

If you do not plan to attend one of these sessions, you will still be able to participate in one of the Worker Environmental Training programs at a later date if you wish (all workers and visitors to the project are required to take a one-hour environmental training program prior to starting work/visiting the ROW).

A short description of the programs and the locations of the training programs are provided below.

Overview

The **Supervisor Level Environmental Training** will be held for all Contractor Foremen, Superintendents, Project Construction Inspectors, and field supervisory and management personnel involved with construction and oversight on the project. Agency representatives will also be invited to attend this session.

This full-day program will cover the following main topic areas:

- Keystone's Commitment to meeting environmental requirements and landowner agreements
- Roles and responsibilities of project supervisory and inspection staff
- Keystone's Environmental Inspection and Compliance Management Program (expectations, approaches to handling compliance issues, training program, etc.)
- Project environmental requirements, resource issues, and regulatory agency expectations
- Permit conditions, commitments and environmental resource protection/mitigation requirements during construction

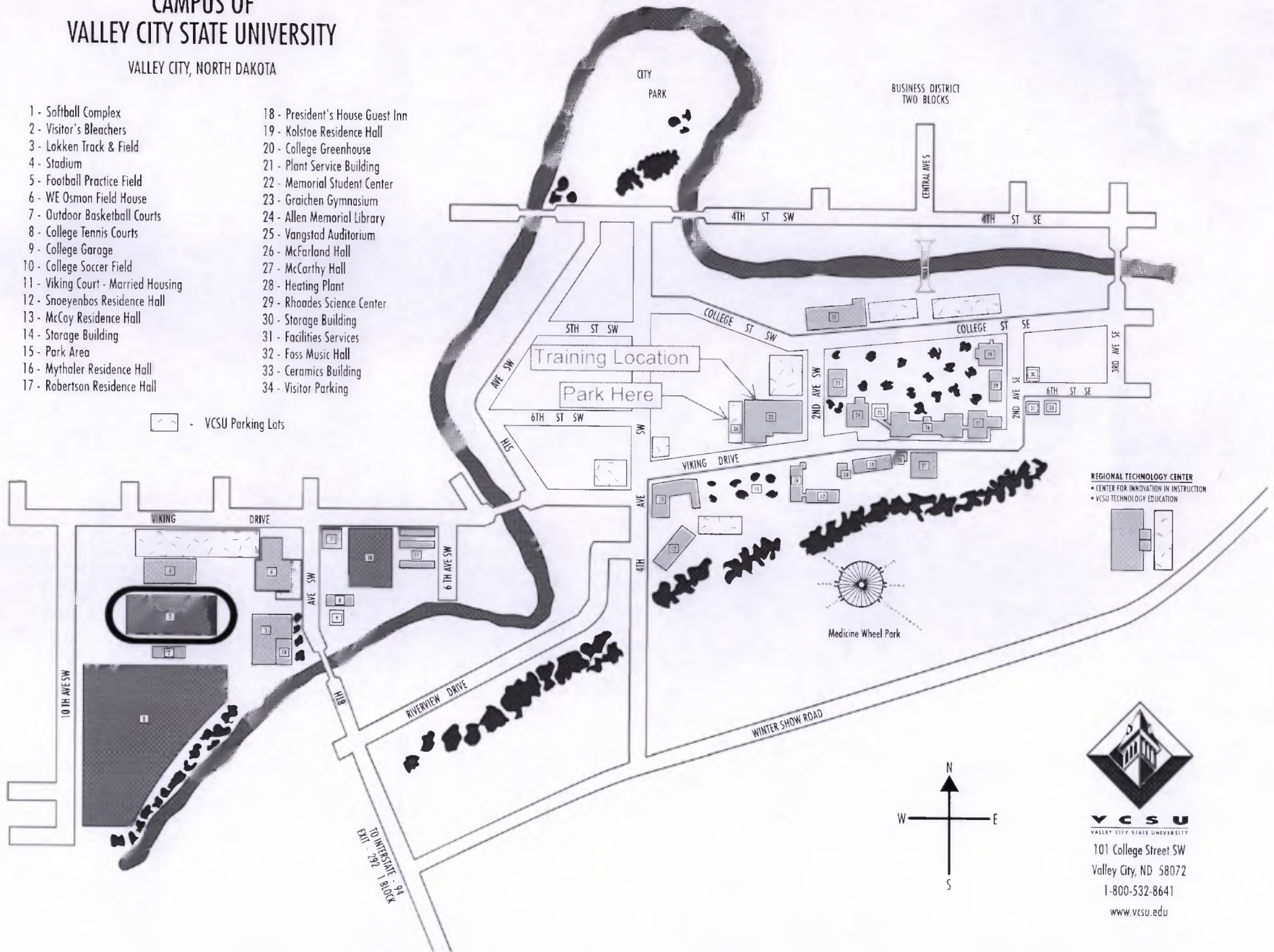
