Notice to North Dakota State Senators and Representatives Pursuant to Section 69-06-01-02 ND Admin Code:

TransCanada Keystone Pipeline has previously filed with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (PSC) a Motion dated April 29, 2008 for approval of certain pending route refinements. You previously received notice of that filing. Subsequently, there was a survey which identified two cultural resource sites located along the proposed route for two landowners. As a result, Keystone has modified the route to avoid those two sites and two maps are attached that show the proposed route refinement to avoid the sites as identified.

The PSC is being asked by Keystone to approve these route refinements which include the changes shown on the two attached maps. Keystone is providing this email notice to each of the State Senators and Representatives who have their Legislative Districts located along the proposed route with a deadline for comment on these two changes that have been filed with the PSC. This email is intended to provide notification to you that any comments on the two changes as proposed be provided in writing to the attention of Patrick Fahn at the PSC located at 600 East Boulevard - Dept 408 in Bismarck, with a copy of such written comments also mailed or emailed to the undersigned, by **no later than 5:00 p.m.** central time on **Thursday, May 22, 2008.**
