WAIVER OF 500 FOOT BUFFER ZONE
AVOIDANCE AREA REQUIREMENT

The undersigned hereby agrees and consents to waive the five hundred foot buffer zone requirement for the statutory avoidance area as set forth in Section 69-06-08-02(2)(e) of the North Dakota Administrative Code with respect to the existence of the undersigned's residence in connection with the TransCanada Keystone Pipeline. Therefore, to the extent that the undersigned's residence is located within that five hundred foot range from the proposed TransCanada Keystone Pipeline location, the undersigned hereby expressly waives the required five hundred foot buffer zone distance.

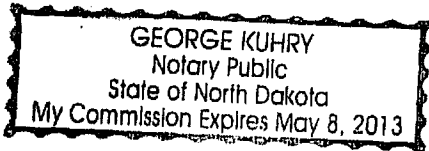

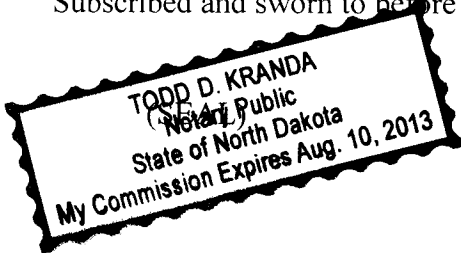


