Dear Todd and Pat:

We have received and reviewed the correspondence and map documentation provided for the proposed Novak-Sticka and Capp reroutes, respectively.

A portion of the proposed Novak-Sticka reroute was very recently inventoried for cultural resources and a newly recorded site--a stone foundation remnant--MAC-WA-01 (32WA260) was recorded in it. This site warrants a formal evaluation regarding its significance and eligibility for the National Register of Historic Places if it is to be impacted and not avoided. It is our understanding that reporting of the investigations will be forthcoming in Addendum 15 to Keystone.

At this time, no concerns are noted with respect to the Capp reroute.

If additional information comes to our attention before 5:00 pm , 5/29, we will address and relay as necessary.

Notice to State Agencies and Officials as Identified Pursuant to Section 69-06-01-05 ND Admin Code:

TransCanada Keystone Pipeline has filed with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (PSC) a Motion dated May 27, 2008 for approval of two route refinements within the approved corridor. The proposed two route refinements are limited and relate to certain adjustments along the route to accommodate landowners involved and are deemed necessary for a voluntary easement acquisition.

As additional information to assist you in identifying the specific two areas involved with the Motion for 2 route refinements, attached please find PDF copies of Exhibit A (Novak/Sticha route deviation map), Exhibit D (Capp route deviation map) and Exhibit E (the revised route map).
