

By way of an explanation, this map, Substitute Exhibit D, shows the original route as approved (red), the revised route as was submitted previously with the May 27, 2008 Motion (yellow with orange) and now the second revised route as is requested for approval (yellow). This substitution map is necessary because the route has been changed in order to avoid the residential structure of the Capp home which lies adjacent to the refined route. Accordingly, this map should be a substitute for Exhibit D and is intended to be submitted for the route refinement that is being requested for approval regarding what has been referred to as the Capp Route Deviation.
