**MOTION FOR APPROVAL
OF EXTRA WORK SPACE IN SHELTER BELT AREA
WITH
REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW**

TransCanada Keystone Pipeline LP (Keystone) hereby requests that the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) review and approve extra work space in certain shelter belt areas.


As proposed by Keystone and for the reasons expressed in the supporting Affidavit of Loys A. Gray III, additional work space is required beyond the 50 feet currently allowed in certain shelter belts along the route. Based on actual construction experience and a conclusion that has been made by Keystone since the Commission issued its determination on the 50 feet of work space, it has been determined that additional work space is necessary for these shelter belt areas as are more precisely described within the maps and photos attached to the supporting Affidavit of Loys A. Gray III.

Furthermore, a request is being made that the Commission expedite its review and consideration of this additional work space for certain shelter belt areas and upon doing so approve the request at the earliest possible opportunity. There are ground construction activities continuing with both Spreads 1A and 2A in North Dakota and this additional work space request effects those continuing construction activities along the route.

The reasons for this request and for the expedited review and approval is specifically addressed by the attached and supporting Affidavit of Loys A Gray, III.

In conclusion, Keystone respectfully requests that the Commission expedite its review and approve Keystone's Motion for approval of extra work space in the shelter belt areas as described.
