Subject: Case No. PU-06-421, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP:  
July 11, 2008 Pre-construction Conference

In Case No. PU-06-421 the Commission ordered that a conference be held prior to construction of the Keystone Pipeline. The order required that the conference include a TransCanada representative, its construction supervisor, and Commission staff to insure TransCanada fully understands the conditions set forth in the order.

On May 8, 2008 a pre-construction conference was held with TransCanada representatives and construction supervisors with respect to pipeline construction. On July 11, 2008 a pre-construction conference was held (by conference call) with TransCanada representatives and construction supervisors with respect to pump station construction.

In attendance for the July 11 conference were Todd Kranda (Kelsch Kelsch Ruff & Kranda), Harold Yarn (Facilities Manager, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP), Randy Basham (Construction Manager, Bechtel), Xavier Brito (Deputy Construction Manager, Bechtel), Chris Buchholz (Senior Operations Manager, TIC-Wyoming), Butch Lafollette (Project Superintendent, TIC-Wyoming).

The conference included a review of the order's findings of fact and ordering clauses, the penalty provisions of NDCC § 49-22-21, and a question and answer period.
