

REQUEST TO WITHDRAW
MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF PENDING ROUTE REFINEMENT

TransCanada Keystone Pipeline LP (Keystone) hereby requests that the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) approve the withdrawal of the recently filed July 10, 2008 Motion which was submitted for approval of an additional route refinement in response to landowner negotiations.

After further discussions, all landowners along the Keystone route have now reached an agreement with Keystone for the pipeline. Voluntary easements are being entered into with the landowners. As a result of the negotiations with the three landowners in Barnes County which would have been effected by the route refinement in the pending Motion, the agreements that have been reached between Keystone and the specific landowners negates the need for the route refinement that was being requested.

Accordingly, Keystone respectfully requests that the pending July 10, 2008 Motion be withdrawn without an informal hearing and that the informal hearing that was scheduled for that matter be cancelled.


