Job Site: SOUTH SPREAD

Date: 8-8-08

Location and Operations Observed: MP 148 WELDING
MP 166 DITCHING & LOWER IN
MP 168-169 CLEARING, BACKFILLING

General Notes: AT MP 148 I OBSERVED THE WELDING OPERATIONS
ON THE STARKS PROPERTY. I ALSO RANDOMLY MEASURED
THE THICKNESS OF THE PIPE WITH A CALIPER. MY MEASUREMENTS
VERY CLOSELY MATCHED THE THICKNESS STAMPED ON THE PIPE.
THE THICKNESS OF PIPE INSTALLED ON THE STARKE PROPERTY
IS 0.438" AND 0.386" ON EITHER ADJACENT PROPERTY.
THE PIPE ON THE STARKE PROPERTY IS CURRENTLY BEING
WELDED.

AT MP 166 I OBSERVED THE DITCHING OPERATION.
EACH EXCAVATOR HAS A SPOTTER TO MONITOR THE
"SPREAD" OF THE SUBSOIL PILE. I SAW NO CASES
WHERE THE SUBSOIL SPILLED ONTO THE ADJACENT

TOPSOIL. THE LOWERING CREW PLANS TO SET PIPE
LATER IN THE DAY.

AT MP 168-169 I MEASURED THE STAKED
WIDTH OF R.O.W. THRU WOODED AREAS AT 50'. THE
R.O.W. IS WIDENED IN AREAS AND UNDER BRUSH HAS
BEEN CLEARED. THE CLEARED & STRIPPED WIDTH
BETWEEN HJELLE PKWY AND THE SHEYENNE RIVER IS
110'. TOPSOIL IS STRIPPED IN THIS AREA IN EXCESS
OF 12".

LANDOWNER TINGELY WAS IN THE AREA OF
MP 169 AND HE AND I DISCUSSED ASPECTS OF
THE PROJECT. HE COMMENTED THAT DUST FROM
HAUL ROADS WAS HEAVY AT TIMES. HE ALSO
SAID THAT ADJACENT SOYBEANS AND CORN CROPS
SHOWED THE EFFECTS OF BEING DUST-COVERED.
I TOLD HIM THAT I WOULD REPORT THE INFORMATION.


