The abandoned home is on the property of Doug Waslaski, 1822 E. Linda Lane, Gilbert, AZ 85324. It is located in Nekoma Township in the SW corner of Section 13 – T159N – R60W approximately 900-feet south of turbine site #47. Construction at the turbine #47 site will start after the first part of July.
