Langdon Renewables, LLC (“Langdon Renewables”) is in receipt of your August 2, 2021 correspondence requesting monthly status updates regarding Aircraft Detection Lighting System (“ADLS”) at the Langdon Wind Energy Center located in Cavalier County, North Dakota. Case No. PU-18-336, Docket No. 26; Case No. PU-07-026, Docket No. 198. The below information is provided in response to your request. As background, on October 2, 2020, Langdon Renewables filed a Certification Relating to N.D.C.C. § 49-22-03(3)(a) pertaining to ADLS installation activities at the facility. Case No. PU-20-413, Docket No. 1 (the “Certification”). As stated in the Certification, activities to install ADLS commenced in fall of 2020 through fourth quarter 2020 as weather allowed.

Since this time, installation resumed spring 2021. Installation of ADLS hardware is almost complete and the system will subsequently undergo various networking and testing. ADLS is anticipated to be implemented in advance of the December 31, 2021 statutory deadline. Once implementation is complete, a notice will be filed in accordance with N.D. Admin. Code § 69-06-11-02(5). Following implementation, Langdon Renewables and its ADLS vendor will continue fine-tuning and optimizing system performance.
