Dear Secretary Jeffcoat-Sacco:

In accordance with NDCC Section 49-22 of the North Dakota Public Service Commission's administrative rules, Just Wind LLC, ("Just Wind") respectfully submitted in February of this year a Letter of Intent to File an Application for a Wavier of Procedures and Time Schedules, and a Combined Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and a Transmission Facility Siting Permit, regarding Logan County Wind Farm. The Commission acknowledged Just Wind's Letter of Intent and granted Just Wind's request to shorten the one year waiting period between filing a letter of intent and a siting application to one day. The commission also assessed a filing fee of \$100,000 siting application fee payable upon the filing of the application.

Prior to July 1, 2007, Just Wind submitted one original and ten (10) copies of the Ten Year Plan Report, within a few days of that submission, a staff member from the Public Service Commission requested Just Wind to submit the report in an electronic format, which was done. The report contains as much information as available at this time. It is the intention of Just Wind to update and improve this information. As that happens, updated copies of reports, studies and findings will be forwarded to the North Dakota Public Service Commission.


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Due to the fact that the Public Service Commission Guidelines regarding Chapter 49-22, NDCC, Energy Conversion and Transmission Facility Siting, were really not written for wind farm projects, I respectfully ask if Just Wind's Ten Year Plan information could be used for the Certificate of Site Compatibility, the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility, and the Permit for a Transmission Facility. Based on review of the Guidelines, most of the requested information is the same as the information in our Ten Year Plan. I have included all three, (3), categories in the request. However, some of the requested information is overlapping and in the case of a wind farm probably does not apply. As mentioned earlier, Just Wind plans to update the Public Service Commission with all completed information pertaining to the project. The reason for this request is to alleviate the Public Service Commission and its staff from having to review approximately 33 additional copies of the same material, both of which you have as a hard copy and in electronic format. Thank you.
