NSP Time of Day On-Peak Periods Tariff Changes

On February 20, 2007, NSP filed tariff changes temporarily redefining the on and off-peak hours of its Time-of-Day tariff schedules to accommodate the 2007 extension of Daylight Savings Time (DST) under Section 110 of EAct-05. The commission approved the changes March 7, 2007. The purpose of the changes was to avoid reprogramming meters until it is known if the DST extension is permanent.

The temporary tariff changes shifted NSP's on-peak period from beginning at 9:00 a.m. to beginning at 10:00 a.m. and from ending at 9 p.m. to ending at 10 p.m. during the periods (1) March 11 until the first Sunday in April and (2) the last Sunday in October to the First Sunday in November. NSP stated that it would reprogram the meters and re-file tariff changes when a permanent DST period is established.

NSP now believes that the DST extension is permanent and has completed the reprogramming of its TOD metering equipment prior to the DST change on October 26, 2008.

I recommend the proposed tariffs be approved. The proposed tariffs today are the same tariffs that were in effect prior to the temporary tariffs.
