Patrick,

Per our conference call last week, I've assembled items that you requested for your files concerning the Enbridge LSR Project. These items include:

1. Updated list of meeting attendees (June 18th teleconference) - attached
2. Copies of all permits issued for the LSR Project in North Dakota - attached
3. Information on Access Roads - attached
4. Wet Weather Shut Down: Section 1.12 of Enbridge's EMP (attached as a separate email) addresses the conditions in which Enbridge would implement a wet weather shutdown of construction activities.
5. Tongue River cultural resource survey information (see below).

The route adjustment at the Tongue River was developed and adopted came as a result of the Route Permit (as issued in December, 2007). Due to the timing of the Route Permit, cultural resource surveys for the Tongue River route adjustment could not be completed until spring of 2008. Enbridge submitted the 2007 cultural resource survey report to the ND SHPO for review and concurrence. Enbridge received concurrence from the ND SHPO on the 2007 report. The surveys of the Tongue River route adjustment found no new cultural resource sites. A previous cultural resource survey (Lakehead Cap X Project, 1998) had identified one site in the route adjustment area, however, this site could not be relocated during the 2008 surveys. This site was previously determined to be ineligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. A 2008 Addendum Report that includes the Tongue River Route Adjustment was completed and provided to the U.S. State Department for review. As the lead Federal Agency, the State Department will pass the Addendum Report on to the ND SHPO for concurrence after the State Department has concurred with the findings of the report.

As we discussed, I will continue to work with you to provide weekly updates of the project progress. I'm developing a format based on discussions with folks that have worked on former Enbridge projects in North Dakota. This format will include:

- Digital photographs
- Description of work completed
- Description of work proposed for the upcoming week.

Enbridge will also continue to work with you regarding the timing of replanting trees with consideration for Enbridge's upcoming Alberta Clipper Project. Additionally, Enbridge will continue to coordinate with you regarding the submittal of the electronic as-built line information post construction.

Please let me know if you need any additional materials to add to your project files.
