Enbridge would request that this alternative be put in the PSC orders.

Could we say something like....." Enbridge hasn't completed archy survey on the north side of the corridor at the Tongue crossing since earlier filed routes with the Commission were proposed crossing on the south side.

Per the crossing options presented by Commission staff, Enbridge would prefer to construct both of the pipelines on the north side and will complete archy surveys on the north as soon as the season permits. These findings will be presented to the ND SHPO and the Commission once completed. If there are findings on the north side, Enbridge will cross the Tongue River on the south side using an HDD technique"... Just trying to brainstorm and throw out some other options to the group as it is highly unlikely we will have an archy finding on the north side.
