**Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership
36-inch LP Pipeline/Pembina County
Siting Application**

Case No. PU-07-108

Facility: 1,000 miles of 36-inch liquid petroleum pipeline extending from Hardisty, Alberta, Canada to Enbridge Energy's existing terminal and tank farm facility in Superior, Wisconsin. 28 miles of pipeline in North Dakota parallel to existing Enbridge pipelines.

Purpose: Increase capacity for transportation of crude petroleum from Alberta oil sands to U.S. markets.

Design Flow rate: 500,000 barrels per day; maximum allowable pressure: 1050 to 1313 pounds per square inch (gauge); maximum product temperature: 104 degrees Fahrenheit.

Cost estimate: \$63.5 million (ND portion).

Schedule: Construction proposed to begin in October 2008. Estimated in-service date is December 2009.

History: Letter of Intent filed March 16, 2007. Application for corridor certificate and route permit filed July 16, 2007. Hearing held October 2, 2007.
