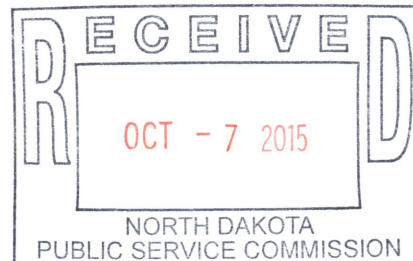

APPLICANT'S CERTIFICATION
ENBRIDGE ENERGY, LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

I, Bradley F. Shamla, a duly authorized agent of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (EELP) do hereby certify under oath:


1. That EELP and/or its legal predecessor(s) in interest constructed and developed facilities for its Alberta Clipper Pipeline Project under Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No.100 and Route Permit No.110 issued by the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("ND-PSC") on December 31, 2007, Docket No. PU-07-108;
2. That the Alberta Clipper Pipeline was designed, constructed, and is operating according to DOT regulations 49 CFR Part 195 – Transportation of Hazardous Liquids by Pipeline.
3. That the Alberta Clipper Pipeline produced minimal direct impacts to the local economy due to the size and duration of the Project.
4. That necessary waivers for all inhabited residences with 500 feet of the pipeline were obtained and are included as Attachment A to this Certification. Further explanation for the two waivers not obtained is also included in Attachment A.
5. That cathodic protection was installed on the pipeline as outlined in Section B.9.c (3) of the Application for Route Permit.
6. That no construction took place through wetlands during nesting season.
7. That Post-construction monitoring is occurring per the Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications per Ordering Paragraph No. 22. The initial report was filed with the ND PSC on January 14, 2014. The second report was filed on September 15, 2015.
8. That the Alberta Clipper Pipeline was buried to a depth of 48 inches except for undeveloped section lines where the pipeline was buried at 72 inches per Ordering Paragraph No. 10 and described in the "as built" spreadsheet filed on March 4, 2010 and included with this filing as Attachment B.
9. That Construction took place according to the manner described in the application and at the hearing and in late filed exhibits and supplemental materials, and in accordance with all applicable safety requirements per Ordering Paragraph No. 9

- 10. That all threatened and endangered species and bald or golden eagles were avoided during construction of the project. The presence of any critical habitat of threatened or endangered species, or of bald or golden eagles would have been promptly reported to the Commission per Ordering Paragraph No.14.
- 11. That no cultural, archeological, and historical resources were impacted by construction of the project per Ordering Paragraph No. 16. If any cultural resource, paleontological resource, archeological resource, historical resource, or gravesite had been discovered during construction, earth disturbing activities would have been halted in the immediate vicinity of the discovery and reported to the SHPO and the Commission immediately.

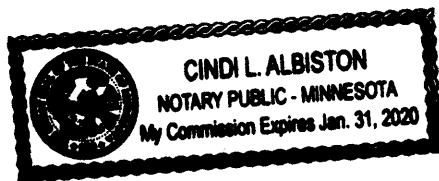

Residence near Milepost 781.1

The structure identified as a residence near Milepost 781.1 was later determined to be an unoccupied farm building, not an occupied rural residence, so no waiver was obtained.

Residence near Milepost 788.5

The waiver for the residence near Milepost 788.5 is included as part of this attachment.

Residence near Milepost 795.3

The residence located near Milepost 795.3 is covered under a blanket easement that was signed in 1950. Four other pipelines built before the Siting Act in North Dakota are closer to this residence than the Alberta Clipper line, so no waiver was sought from this landowner. For each additional pipeline installed, Enbridge paid an "additional line right" payment, but renegotiation was not necessary.

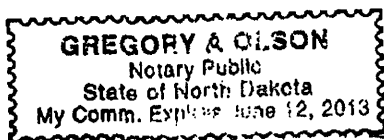

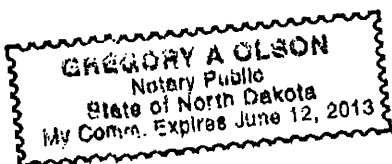
