NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

May 2, 2007

On April 11, 2007, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LLC (TransCanada) filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (PCN) under N.D.C.C. chapter 49-03.1 to construct and operate the Keystone Pipeline in Cavalier, Pembina, Walsh, Nelson, Steele, Barnes, Ransom, and Sargent Counties of North Dakota. Approximately 218 miles of the crude oil pipeline is located in North Dakota.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether public convenience and necessity will be served by construction and operation of the pipeline facilities.
2. Whether the applicants are fit, willing and able to provide service.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding(s) and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearings must be received by **June 22, 2007**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine this matter without a hearing.
