**NOTICE OF HEARING**  
**June 27, 2007**

On April 11, 2007, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LLC (TransCanada) filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (PCN) under N.D.C.C. chapter 49-03.1 to construct and operate the Keystone Pipeline in Cavalier, Pembina, Walsh, Nelson, Steele, Barnes, Ransom, and Sargent Counties of North Dakota. Approximately 218 miles of the crude oil pipeline is located in North Dakota.




On May 2, 2007, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing setting forth the issues to be considered and inviting interested parties to comment or request a hearing by June 22, 2007. On June 21, 2007, the Commission received a request for a public hearing from the Dakota Resource Council.

A **public hearing** on this matter will be held beginning **July 23, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. CDT** at the Barnes County Courthouse, 230 4<sup>th</sup> St NW, Valley City, ND 58072. The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether public convenience and necessity will be served by construction and operation of the pipeline facilities.
2. Whether the applicants are fit, willing and able to provide service.
