*This is to certify that the public convenience and necessity require, and permission is granted, for TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP to construct and operate a 30-inch, 218-mile crude oil pipeline with associated facilities and pipeline interconnections in Cavalier, Pembina, Walsh, Nelson, Steele, Barnes, Ransom, and Sargent Counties, North Dakota.*

*The certificate is conditioned upon and its effectiveness is subject to the Commission granting a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit for the specific corridor and route requested by TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity in Case No. PU-07-152 and in its siting application in Case No. PU-06-421; is further conditioned upon TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP securing the franchise or other authority of the proper municipal or other authority for the exercise of these rights and privileges; and is further subject to the conditions and limitations noted in the Commission's November 21, 2007 Order in Case No. PU-07-152.*
