Enclosed for filing are an original and seven copies of this letter, and an attached amendment to the 2007 Ten Year Plan. Please destroy pages 9 and 10 of the 2007 Ten Year Plan and substitute the attached amended pages 9 and 10. This amendment includes removal of one sentence referencing a map of existing transmission facilities and removal of the map itself.

The purpose for the Ten Year Plan amendment is to remove a reference to the map and the map itself, due to the fact that the map may constitute critical energy infrastructure information under 18 C.F.R. § 388.113. Consequently, inclusion of the map is arguably foreclosed by federal regulations.

Upon Commission approval of this amendment, Otter Tail requests withdrawal of its January 2008 Application for Trade Secret Protection filed in accordance with Section 69-02-09 of the North Dakota Administrative Code.

SECTION D: Proposed Energy Conversion Facilities During the Next Ten-Year Time Period

No new energy conversion facilities owned by Otter Tail are proposed in the ensuing ten-year time period in North Dakota, outside of the Langdon project previously mentioned. The Otter Tail resource plan includes the addition of 160 MW of wind generating facilities, including the Langdon project. Some of the additional new facilities may be located in North Dakota.

SECTION E: Existing Transmission Facilities (Electric)

1. In-service dates for Otter Tail existing transmission facilities above 115 kV are:

Wahpeton - Fergus Falls 230 kV	1967
Hankinson - Wahpeton 230 kV	1967
Forman - Hankinson 230 kV	1967
Ellendale - Forman 230 kV	1967
West Fargo - Audubon 230 kV	1969
Drayton - Grand Forks 230 kV	1970
Big Stone - Hankinson 230 kV	1974
Underwood - Harvey 230 kV	1986
Harvey - Rugby 230 kV	2002

2. No transmission facility rated above 115 kV is scheduled for retirement within the next ten years.

We do not anticipate operating any of the transmission lines at 100% load factor. The nature of Otter Tail's native load makes this impossible.

A map of Otter Tail Power Company's existing transmission facilities in North Dakota is not included here because it may constitute critical energy infrastructure information under 18 C.F.R. § 388.113.
