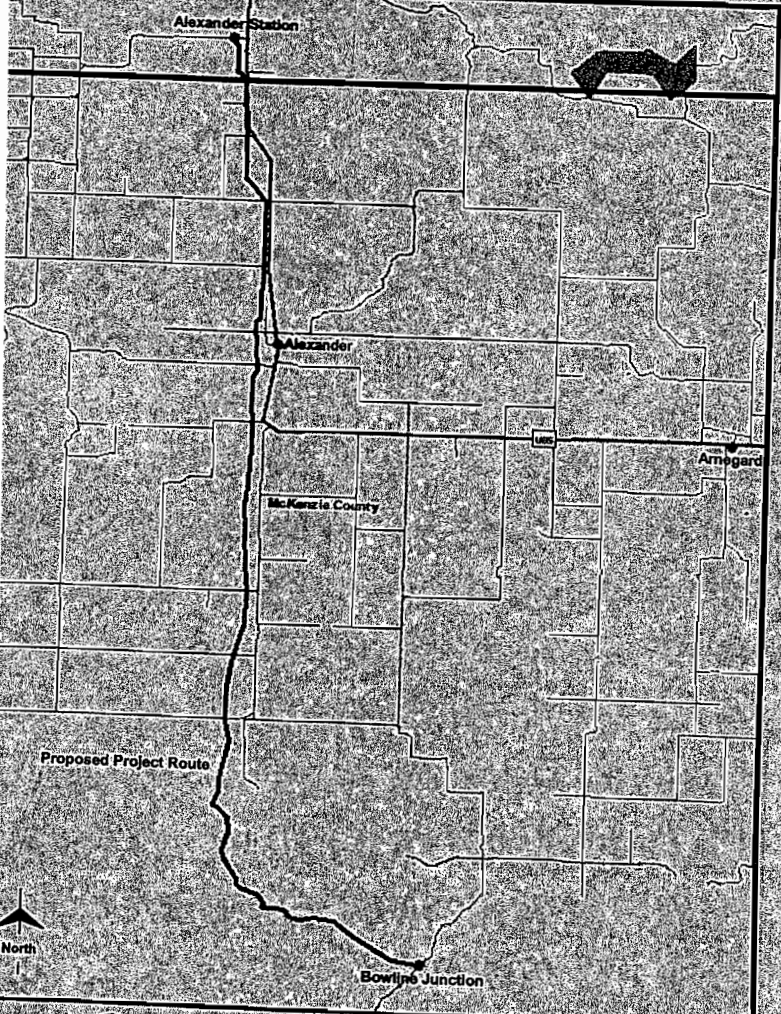


Figure 3.1 - General Project Location

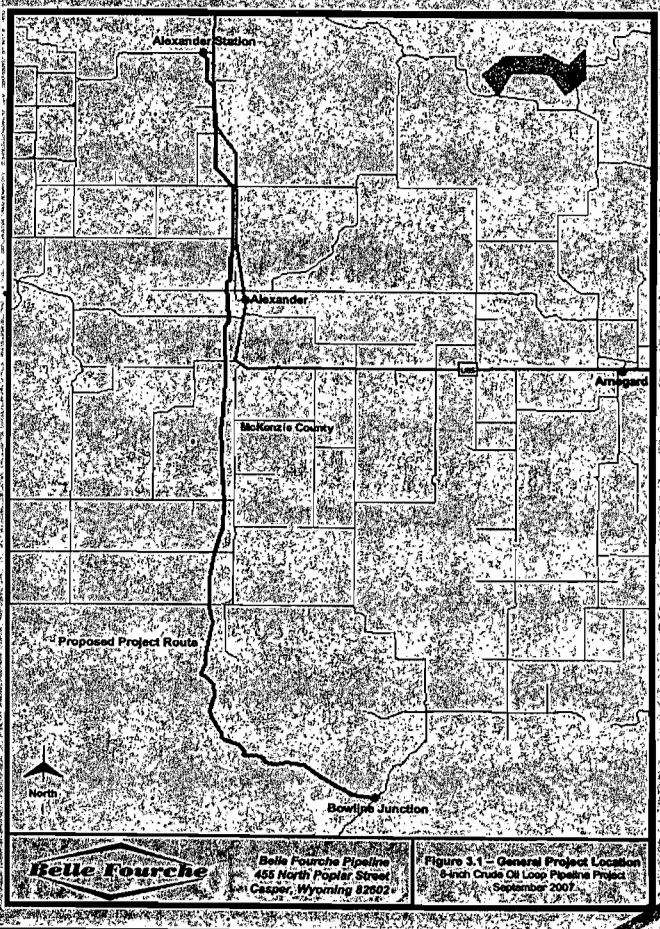

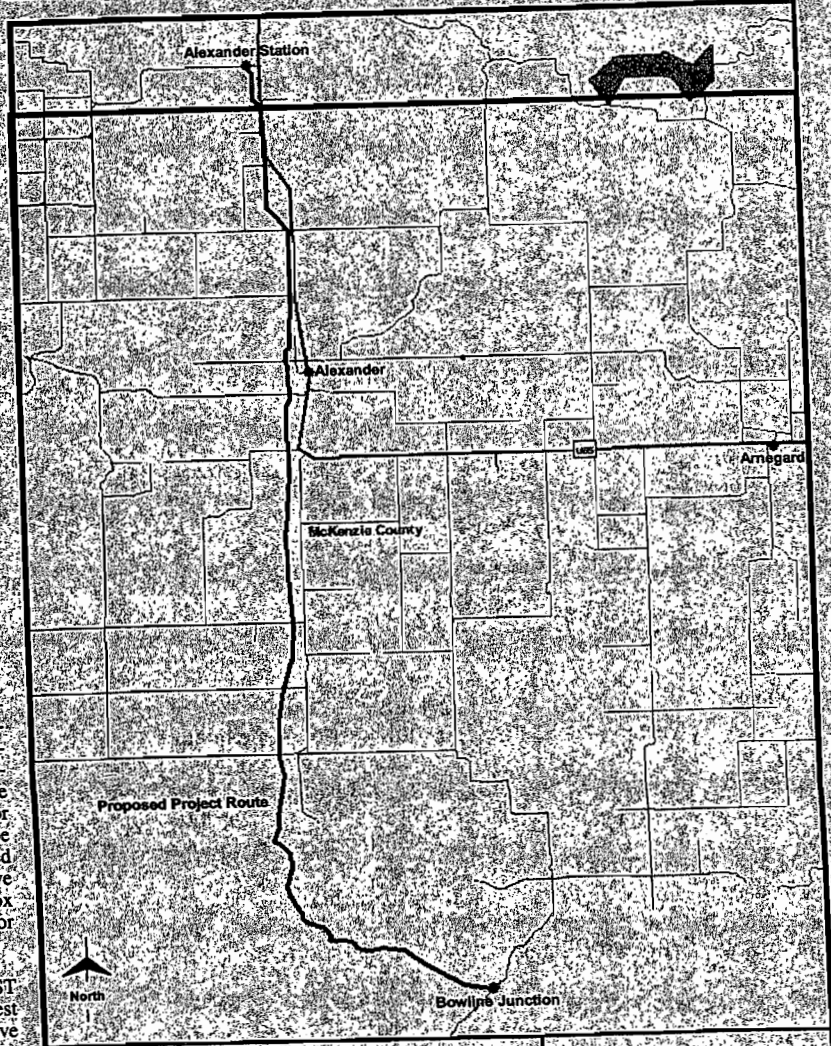


Figure 3.1 - General Project Location
