The location of the new pipeline near the school lies entirely within the corridor evaluated by the SHPO as part of the expansion project.

The SHPO reviewed the entire area and, on September 21, 2006, provided a "No Historic Properties Affected determination provided that the project is of the nature stated... and it takes place in the locations plotted, mapped, and described in the report and other project documentation."

Clearly, the project is of the nature stated (that is, pipeline construction)... and it takes place entirely within the locations plotted, mapped, and described in the report and other project documentation provided to the SHPO.
