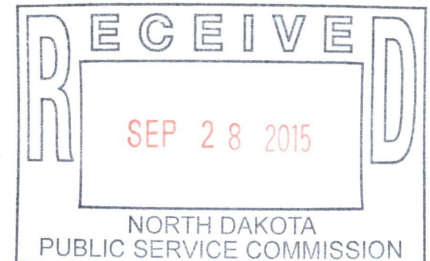

North Dakota Pipeline Company LLC, dba NDPL LLC, formerly known as Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC, provides the enclosed information in response to the request from Mr. Patrick Fahn dated August 18, 2015 regarding Final Construction Inspection Reports. Regarding Docket PU-07-600, Mr. Fahn requested the following:

PU-07-600

On June 29, 2011, the final inspection report was issued for the construction of the Company's 8-inch Crude Petroleum Pipeline Reroute-Williams County (Case No. PU-07-600, Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC, Crude Oil Pipeline Reroute – Williams County, Siting Application). In the report, it was noted that the Company had not yet complied with a number of Order Points. In order to comply with these order points, the Commission requests the following:

- Enbridge should provide a copy of the land easement with the State Management Areas of the ND Lands Department to complete Order Point 5.
- Enbridge should provide a copy of the waiver from the New Public School District #8 for being within 500 feet of the Garden Valley Elementary School to comply with Order Point 6.
- The Company should provide the Commission with the date the pipeline was placed back in service in order to complete Order Point 8.
- A written record of the hydro test should be provided in order to complete Order Point 13.
- Enbridge had not removed four marker posts from the school yards which marked the abandoned line at the time of the final inspection. Enbridge should verify that these marker posts have since been removed to complete Order Point 22.

Attachment A – Land easement with the State Management Areas to complete Order Point 5.

Attachment B – Waiver from Garden Valley Elementary School to complete Order Point 6.

Attachment C – Weekly Report showing the restart of Line 84 to complete Order Point 8.

Attachment D – Hydrotest test summary for Line 84 around Garden Valley Elementary School to complete Order Point 13.

Attachment E – Photographs showing the high pressure designation removed from the signs at Garden Valley Elementary School. The school has requested that the signs remain to designate the location of the inactive pipeline. This information completes Order Point 22.

In consideration of \$3,443.25, this Easement Amendment is executed by the Board of University and School Lands, and its agent, the Commissioner of University and School Lands ("GRANTOR"), and Enbridge Pipelines (ND), LLC, 2505 16th Street SW, Suite 200, Minot, ND, 58701 ("GRANTEE").

WHEREAS, on 13 October 1983, Board of University and School Lands of the State of North Dakota, entered into a Pipeline Easement (ROW #721) allowing Portal Pipe Line Company, 2900 Interfirst One Building, 1401 Elm Street, Dallas, Texas, to use certain state-owned land in the South Half (S1/2) of Section 36, Township 156 North, Range 101 West, Williams County, North Dakota. This easement is filed as Document No. 456403, as recorded on 2 November 1983, in the Williams County Recorder's Office; and

WHEREAS, Portal Pipe Line Company is now known as Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota), LLC, by virtue that certain Certificate Of Amendment Of The Certificate Of Incorporation dated 13 October 1998 and Certificate Of Conversion, dated 23 April 2001, filed of record with the Recorder of Deeds, Williams County, North Dakota, on 18 September 2001, as document number 597880; and

WHEREAS, the Board of University and School Lands of the State of North Dakota, and Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota,) LLC, concurrent with this Amendment of Pipeline Easement, have entered into an agreement to release a portion of this easement (ROW #4968) and abandon a segment of 8-inch pipeline under the terms and conditions of the Pipeline Abandonment Plan and Agreement (ROW #5022).

WHEREAS GRANTEE requests that this easement be amended to provide for the rerouting of the pipeline easement area around a school site in the SW4 of Section 36. The rerouted pipeline shall be located approximately 20-feet southerly of the existing 10-inch pipeline owned by Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota), LLC, as described and depicted on the Kadmas Lee & Jackson, Engineers and Surveyors, Sheet No. W-43, signed August 31, 2007, marked as Exhibit "A1", and Sheet No. W-43(1) dated August 14, 2007, marked as Exhibit "A2", and attached hereto.

THEREFORE, GRANTOR and GRANTEE hereby amend the easement (ROW #721) by the addition of the following described easement area which is a strip of land 33.0 feet wide, 16.5 feet on each side of the following described centerline: Commencing at the southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of Section 36; thence northeasterly on an azimuth of 073°38'45" a distance of 811.64 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence easterly on an azimuth of 092°24'30" a distance of 50.00 feet; thence northeasterly on an azimuth of 043°13'23" a distance of 768.28 feet; thence easterly on an azimuth of 092°23'17" a distance of 659.00 feet; thence southeasterly on an azimuth of 143°42'49" a distance of 745.29 feet; thence easterly on an azimuth of 092°24'30" a distance of 50.00 feet to the Point of Termination. Said point located on an azimuth of 086°26'11" a distance of 2509.21 feet from the southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of Section 36. Said tract contains 1.72 acres.

Brandon —Monte and his crew fixed the gate coming off of CR-8 at AM-31 and put the barbed wire back together with a gate at AM-31. They re-installed an electric fence just west of AM-31 and fixed the gate at 135 th Ave. Monte took his crew to the State Land on Hwy. 2 west of Williston and fixed fence. Fencing crew has completed all fencing and gates.
Rollie and his mulching crew started at 135 th Ave. NW and worked their way back to AM-27. There is approximately one half mile to be mulched in this area. With that done, all mulching will be completed on the East side of Hwy. 2 & 85. They need to mulch a few areas just West of Hwy 2 & 85 and then South to AM-34. These are the only areas to be covered and all mulching will be completed, except the two tie-ends on the Garden Valley School 8" re-route.

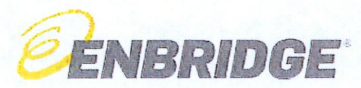

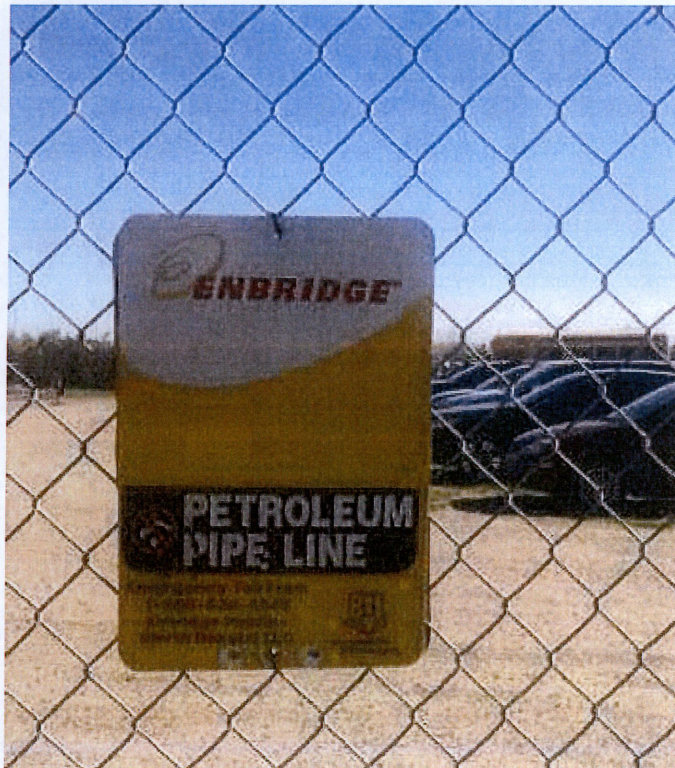
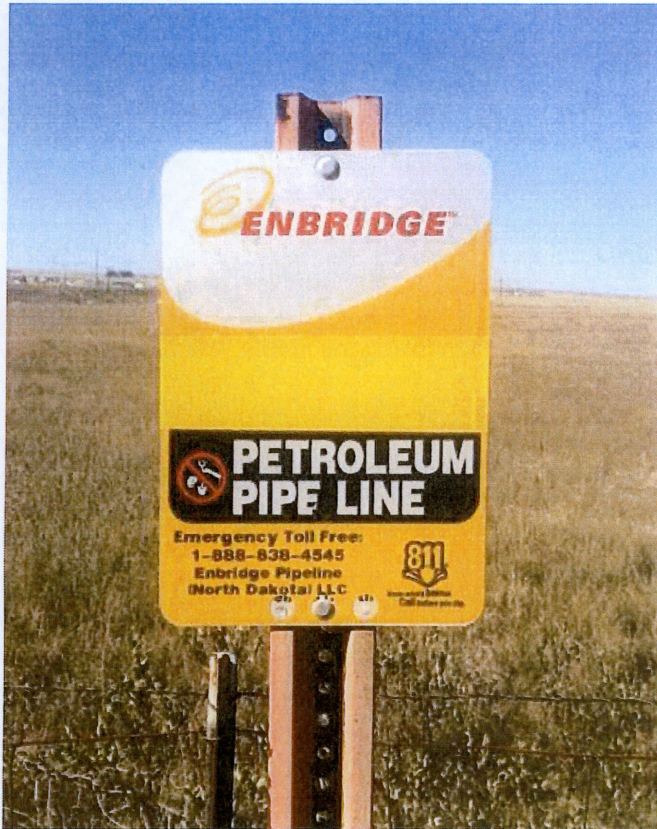
