September 29, 2009
On August 10, 2009, Basin Electric Power
Cooperative, Inc. (Basin Electric) filed an
application for a waiver of procedures and
time schedules and a consolidated applica-
tion for a certificate of corridor compatibil-
ity and route permit to authorize construc-
tion of approximately 61.1 miles of 230 kV
electric transmission line and associated fa-
cilities extending from an existing subst-
ation near Williston to an existing subst-
ation near Tioga, North Dakota, as shown on
the attached map. The Commission finds the
applications are complete conditioned on
Basin Electric filing a map detailing pro-
posed final transmission line structure loca-
tions on or before October 20, 2009. Basin
Electric requests the Commission waive

eration of the proposed facilities produce
minimal adverse effects on the environ-
ment and upon the welfare of the citizens
of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible
with the environmental preservation and
the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations min-
imize adverse human and environmental
impact while ensuring continuing system
reliability and integrity and ensuring that
energy needs are met and fulfilled in an or-
derly and timely fashion?
4. Is it appropriate for the Commission to
waive procedures and time schedules as re-
quested, including the request for a single
consolidated application for corridor cer-
tificate and route permit?

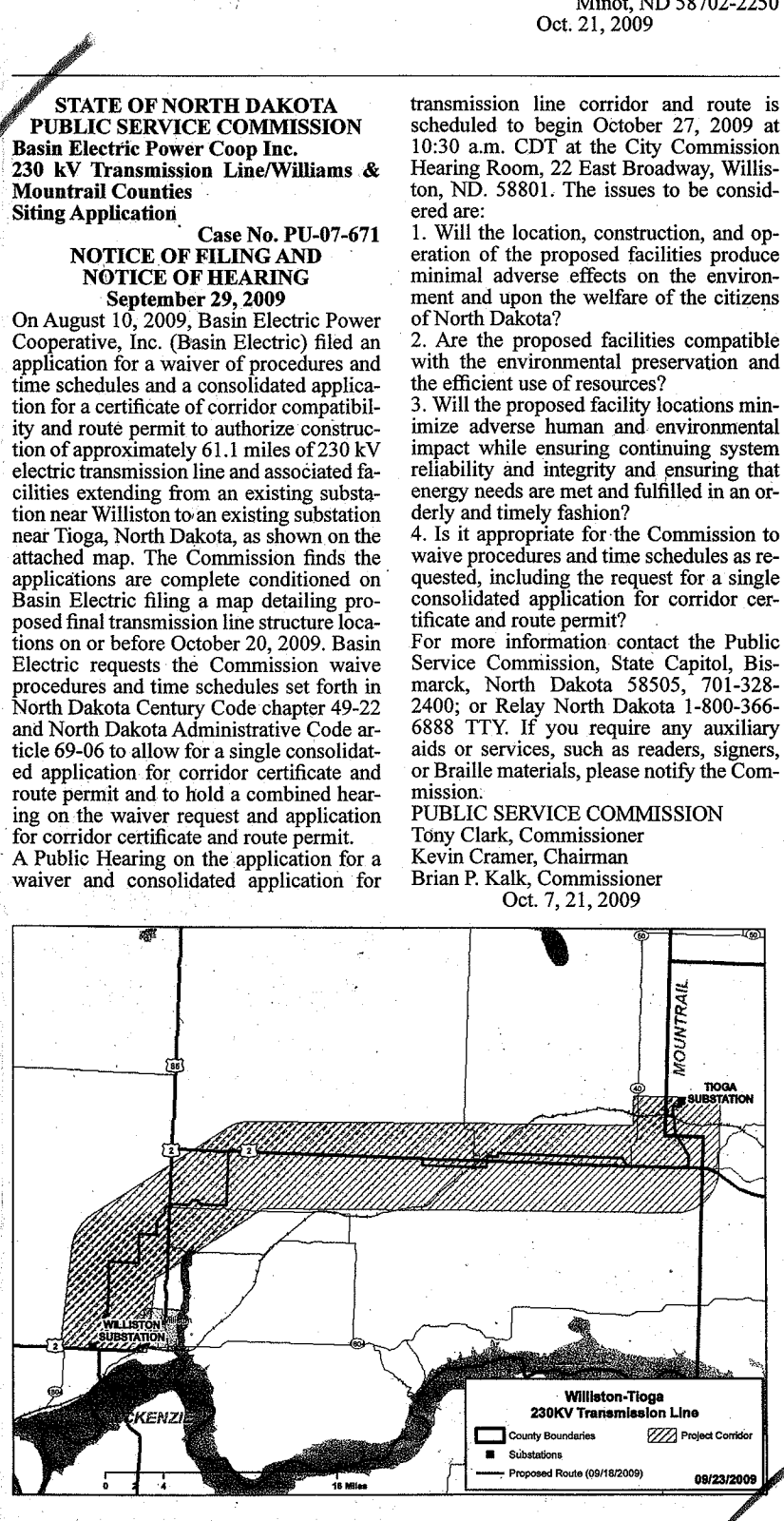
